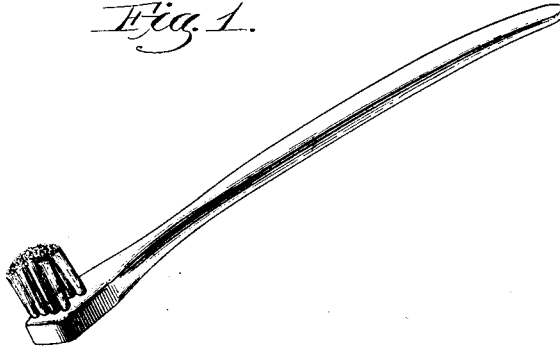

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, HOWARD CLAPP, a citizen of the United States, residing at Boston, county of Suffolk, State of Massachusetts, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Tooth-Brush, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.

Figure 1 of the drawing is a perspective view of a tooth brush showing my new de-

sign; Fig. 2 is a top plan view thereof; and Fig. 3 is a side elevation of the tooth brush showing my new design.
