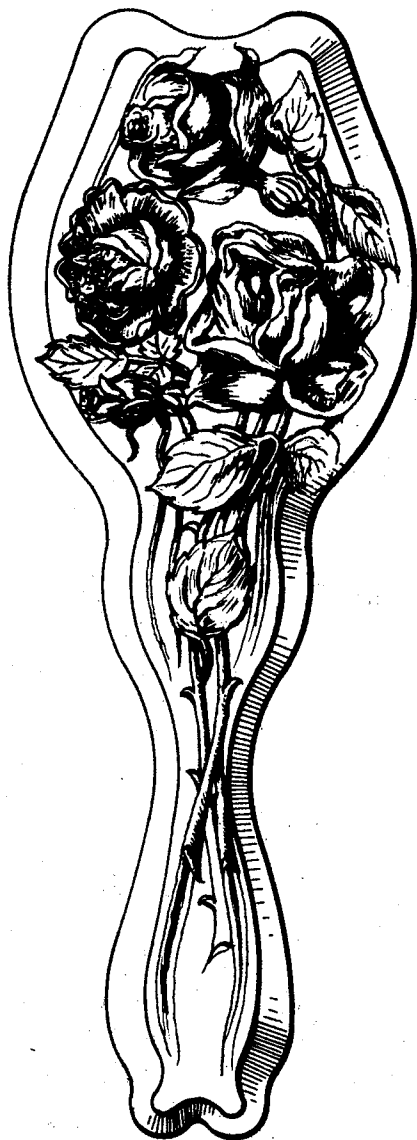

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, WILLIAM H. BLAKE, a citizen of the United States, residing at Attleboro, in the county of Bristol and State of Massachusetts, have invented a certain new, original, and ornamental Design for a Back for Brushes, Mirrors, or Similar Toilet Articles, of which the following is a specification, reference being had therein to the accompanying drawing.
