


DESIGN FOR A CHANDELIER.

Application filed October 5, 1927. Serial No. 23,638. Term of patent 7 years.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, FREDERICK K. MAERZ, a citizen of the United States, residing at Cleveland, in the county of Cuyahoga and State of Ohio, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for Chandeliers, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawings, forming part hereof, wherein—
