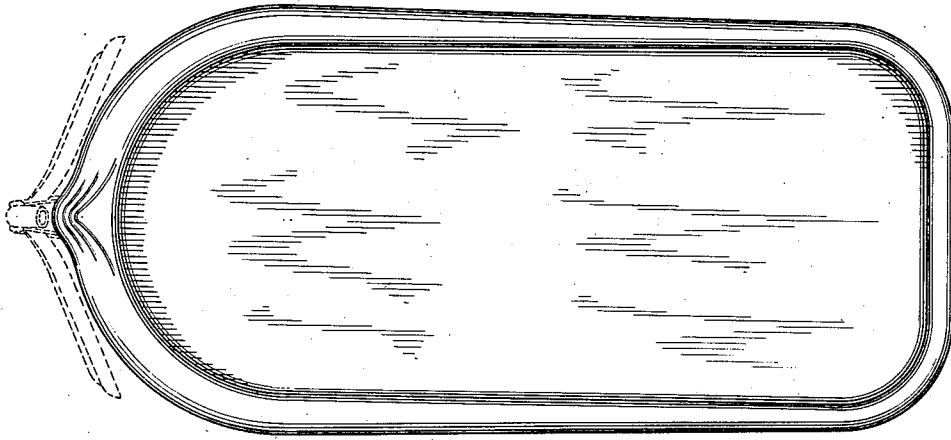
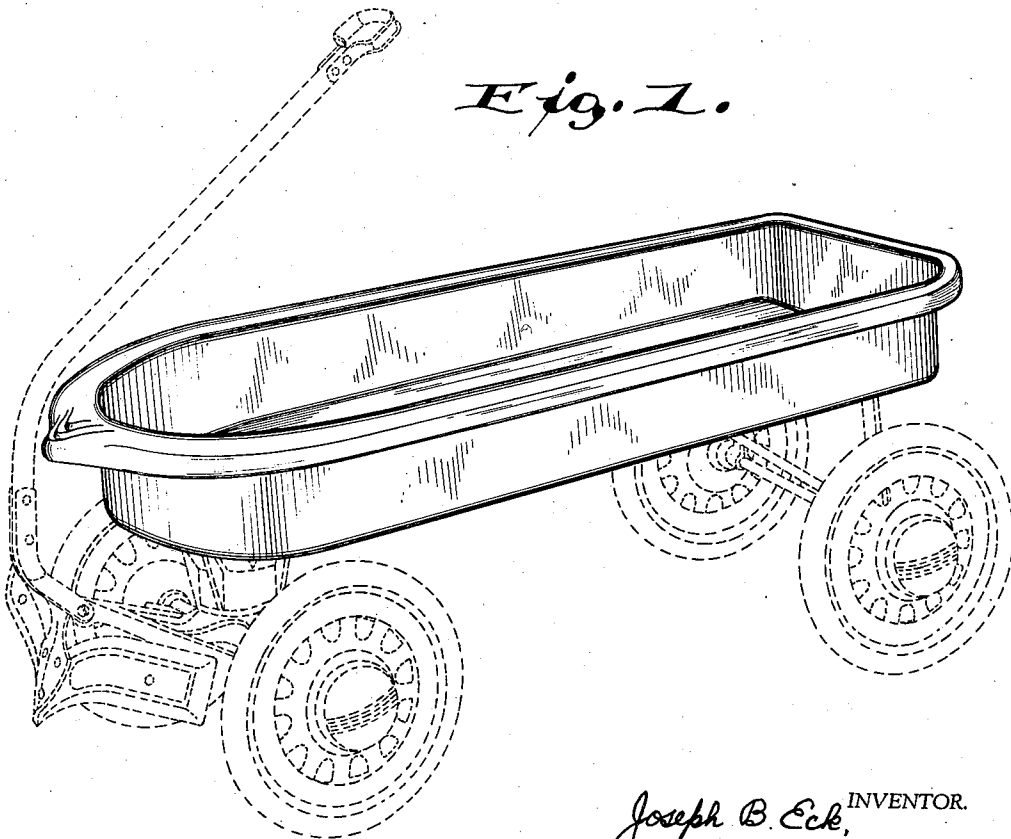

DESIGN FOR A COASTER WAGON

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Joseph B. Eck, a citizen of the United States, residing at Sheboygan, in the County of Sheboygan and State of Wisconsin, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Coaster Wagon, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.

In the drawing:

Fig. 1 is a front and side perspective view; and Fig. 2 is a plan view of a coaster wagon, showing my new design, a portion of the tongue being omitted.

The dominant or important features of the design are shown in solid lines.
