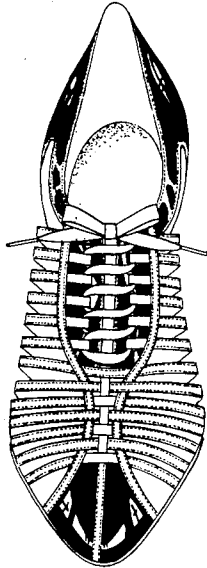

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Julian G. Samuels, a citizen of the United States residing at 6371 Waterman Avenue, in the city of St. Louis, and State of Missouri, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Shoe or Article of Analogous Nature, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part thereof.
