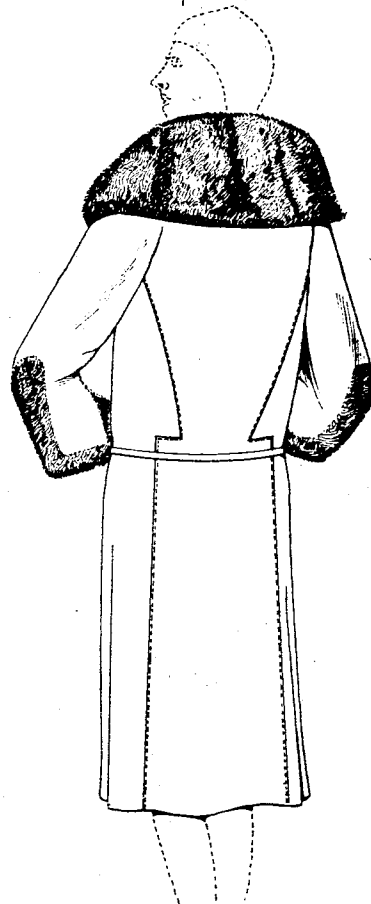
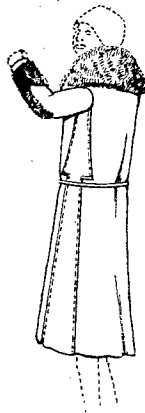

DESIGN FOR A COAT

Application filed August 27, 1930. Serial No. 36,807. Term of patent $3\frac{1}{2}$ years.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, DOROTHY LONG, a citizen of the United States, and a resident of New York city, borough of Manhattan, in the county of New York and State of New York, have invented the new, original, and ornamental Design for Coat, of which the following is a specification.

Reference is had to the accompanying drawings, forming part thereof, wherein—

Figure 1 is a front view of a coat showing my new design, the same being illustrated on a figure indicated in dotted lines;

Figure 2 is a three-fourths rear perspective view of the coat shown in Figure 1, the same being illustrated on a figure indicated by dotted lines;

Figure 3 is a three-fourths side perspective view of the coat shown in Figure 1, the same being illustrated on a figure indicated by dotted lines.
