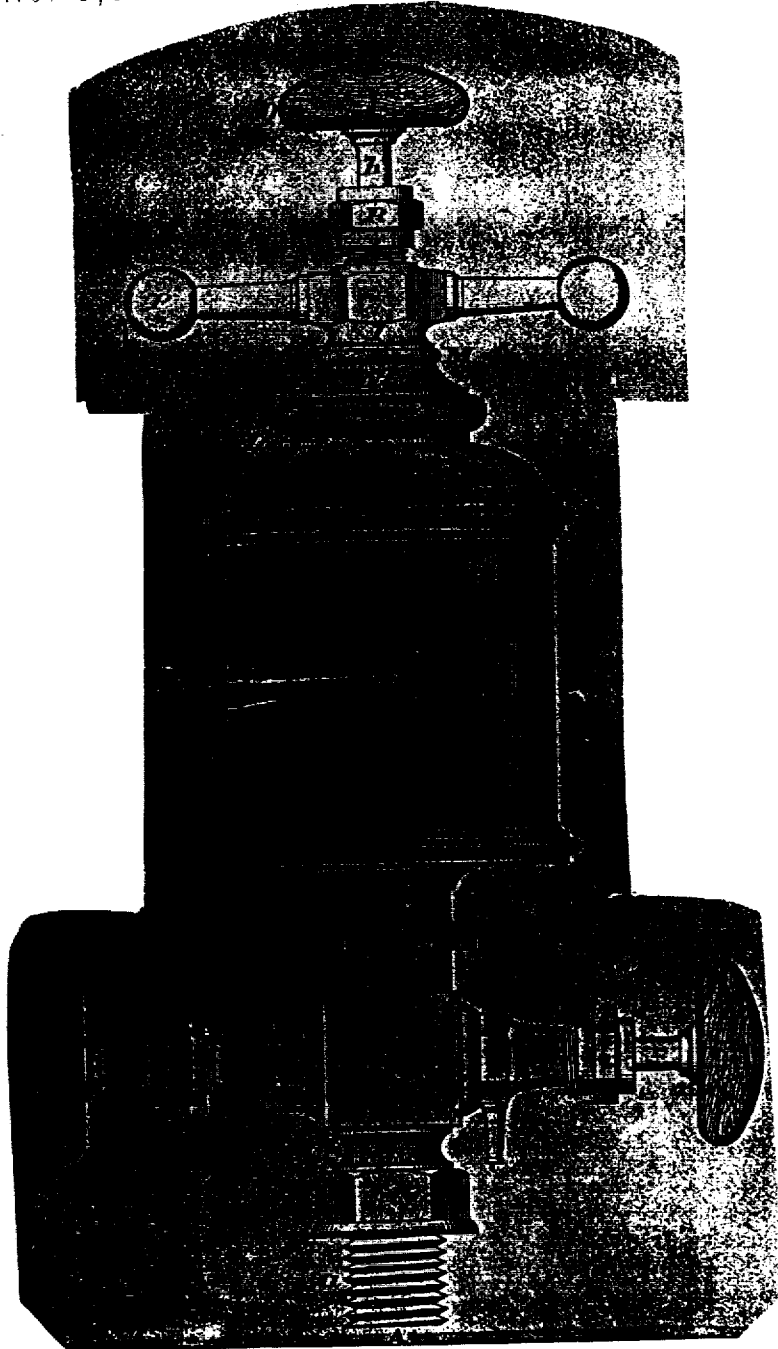

DESIGN FOR A LUBRICATING-CUP.

Specification forming part of Design No. 6,545, dated April 1, 1873; application filed March 21, 1873.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that we, FREDERICK LUNKENHEIMER, of Cincinnati, in the county of Hamilton and State of Ohio, and JAMES MEEHAN, of Covington, in the county of Kenton and State of Kentucky, have invented a new Design for Lubricators, of which the following is a specification:

Our invention relates to the external formation of lubricators which are applied to steam-engines and other machinery, and, occupying a conspicuous position, are frequently made of ornamental appearance.

The accompanying photographic view is a full representation of our design.

The reservoir or main body B of the lubricator is of cylindrical shape, with beads above and below and a convex top, and is surmounted by ornamentally-beaded collars N M. The op-

erating-handles P Q Q' Q² communicate with internal parts which are explained in an application we are about to present for a patent for the construction of our lubricator.

The external conformation of these handles and their symmetrical arrangement, which form parts of our ornamental design, are clearly shown in the photograph.

Claim.

We claim as our invention—

The ornamental conformation of the lubricator, as herein shown and set forth.
