











*To all whom it may concern:*

Be it known that I, Richard Bolton Janes, a citizen of the United States, residing at Baldwin Lake, Greenville, in the county of Montcalm and State of Michigan, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Household Refrigerator, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawings, forming a part hereof.

In the drawings:

Figure 1 is a perspective view of a household refrigerator embodying my new design;

Figure 2 is a fragmentary left-hand side elevational view thereof;

Figure 3 is a fragmentary cross-sectional view taken on substantially the line 3-3 of Figure 1;

Figure 4 is a fragmentary cross-sectional view taken on substantially the line 4-4 of Figure 1;

Figure 5 is a fragmentary cross-sectional view taken on substantially the line 5-5 of Figure 1;

Figure 6 is a fragmentary cross-sectional view

taken on substantially the line 6-6 of Figure 1;

Figure 7 is a fragmentary cross-sectional view taken on substantially the line 7-7 of Figure 1, and

Figure 8 is a fragmentary cross-sectional view taken on substantially the line 8-8 of Figure 1.

The dominant features of my design reside in the portions shown in full lines.

I claim:

The ornamental design for a household refrigerator, substantially as shown and described.
