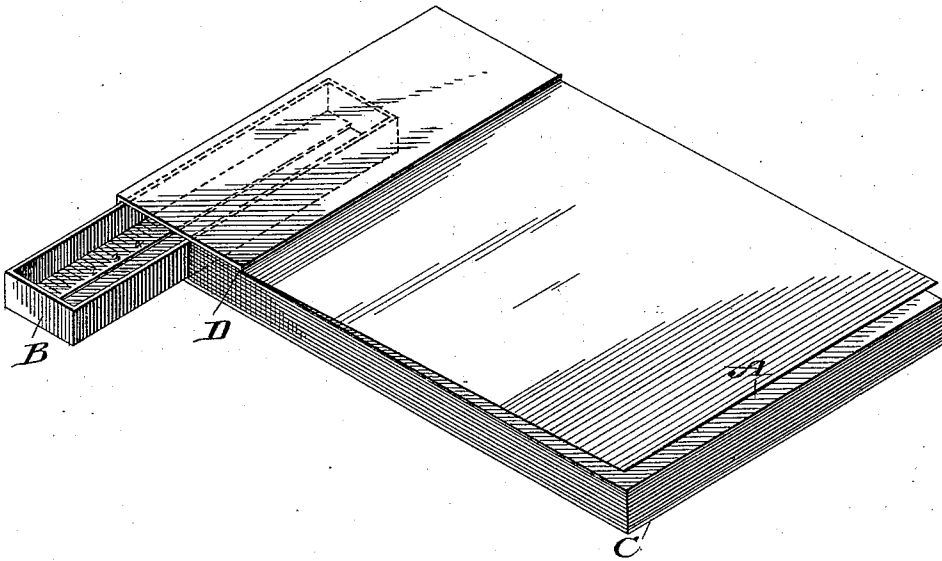
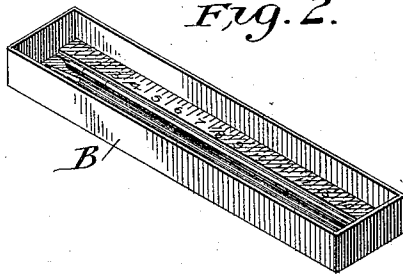

SCHOOL CABINET-TABLET.

SPECIFICATION forming part of Letters Patent No. 566,116, dated August 18, 1896.

Application filed January 2, 1896. Serial No. 574,052. (No model.)

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, WILBUR YOUNG, a citizen of the United States, residing at Fairmont, in the county of Marion and State of West Virginia, have invented and produced a new and original Invention for School Cabinet-Tablets, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawings, showing parts thereof.

Figure 1 represents the entire tablet with drawer partly drawn. Fig. 2 represents the drawer as the contents will appear in it.

A is the tablet; B, the drawer partly drawn; C, the back of tablet, extending beyond the bound end around B and back to D and there overlapping the bound end of the tablet and

securely fastened, which forms a rectangular inclosure in which drawer B slides either to right or left.

I claim—

The tablet heretofore described having a back extending beyond the bound end of the tablet, thence upward, and thence forward, overlapping the bound end of the tablet and secured thereto forming a rectangular inclosure beyond the bound end in combination with a drawer sliding inside of inclosure.
