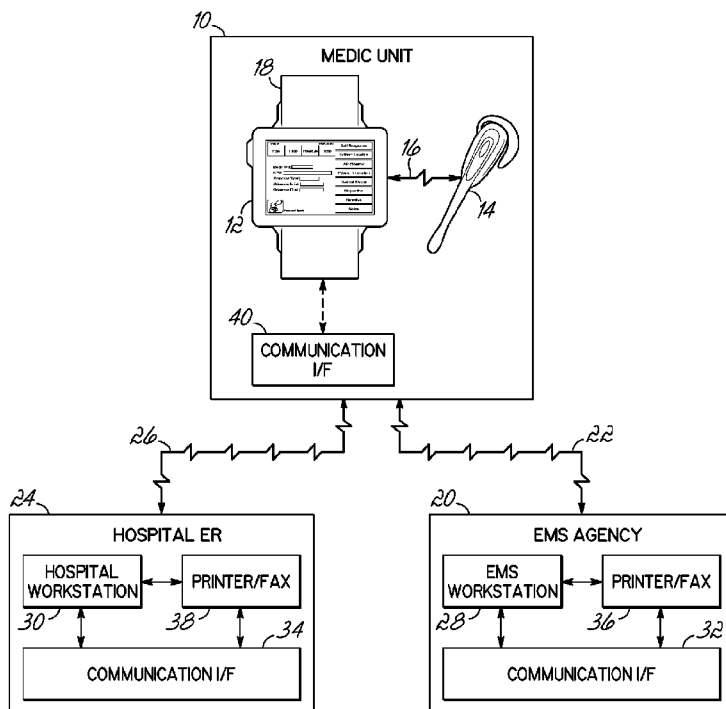

(57) Abstract: A method of documenting information as well as a documentation and communication system for documenting information with a wearable computing device of the type that includes a processing unit and a touchscreen display is provided.
