

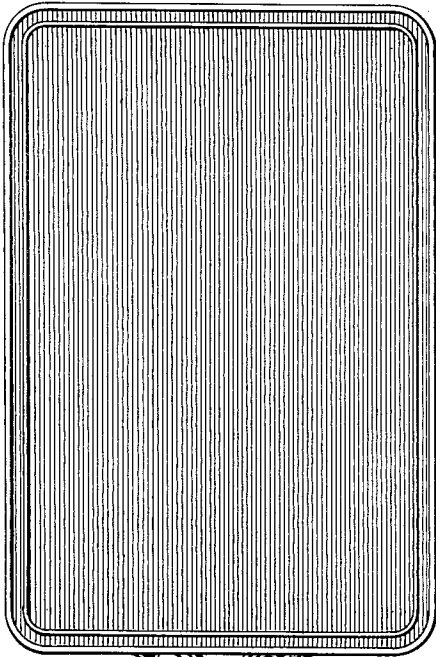

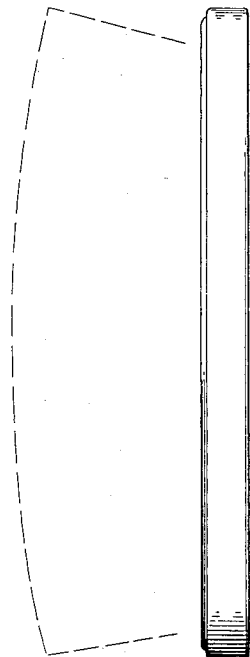

*To all whom it may concern:*

Be it known that I, Albert Wewetzer, a citizen of the United States, residing at Elgin, in the county of Kane and State of Illinois, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Brush or Similar Article, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof, wherein—

Figure 1 is a rear elevation; and

Fig. 2 is a side elevation of a brush or similar article showing my new design.

The dominant feature of the design resides in the portion shown in solid lines.
