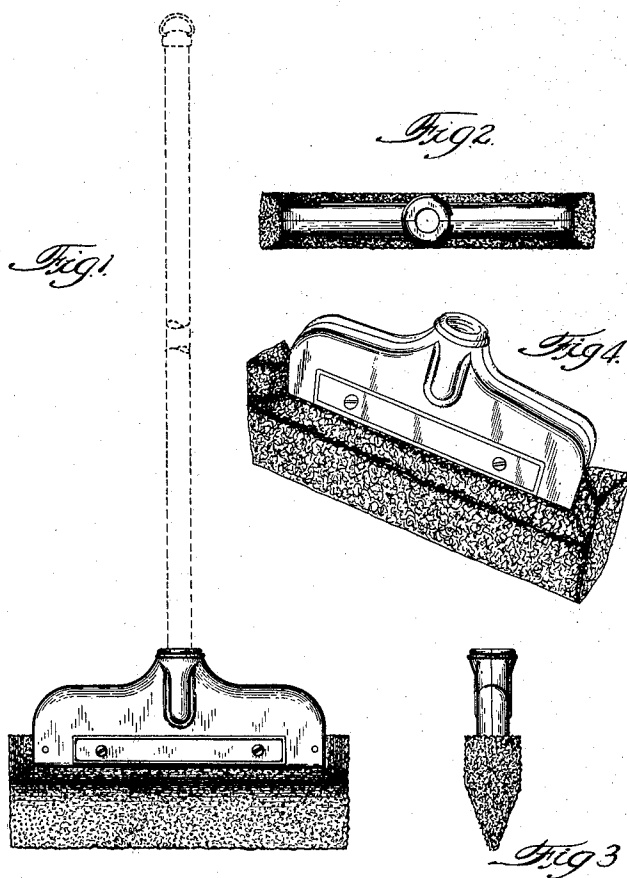


Fig. 1 is a side elevational view of a floor cleaning broom or the like showing my new design;

Fig. 2 is a top plan view thereof;

Fig. 3 is an end view of the broom; and

Fig. 4 is a perspective view thereof.

The dominant feature of my design resides in the portions shown in full lines, the handle being broken away in Fig. 1 to indicate indeterminant length, and omitted in Figs. 2, 3 and 4 for convenience of illustration only.

I claim:
