


Fig. 1 is a side elevational view of a floor cleaning broom or the like showing my new design;

The dominant feature of my design resides in the portions shown in full lines, the handle being broken away in Fig. 1 to indicate indeterminant length, and omitted in Figs. 2, 3 and 4 for convenience of illustration only. I claim:
