

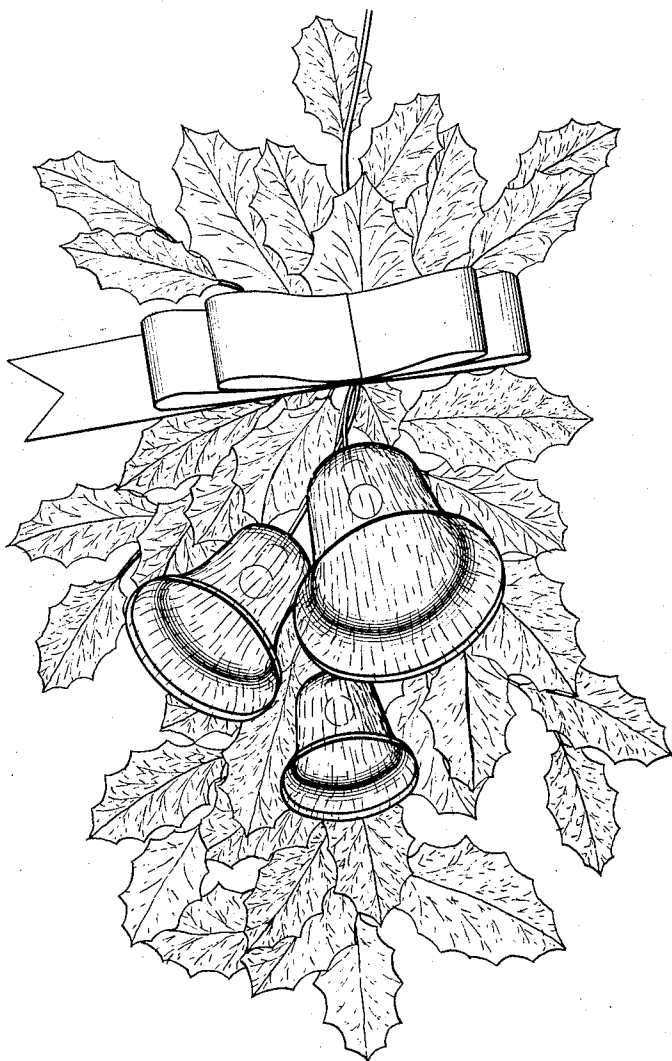

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Joseph I. Adler, a citizen of the United States, residing at Chicago, in the county of Cook and State of Illinois, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Christmas Tree Ornament or Similar Article, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part thereof.

The figure is a front elevational view, slightly

in perspective, of a Christmas tree ornament showing my new design.

The bell elements are made of transparent material and accommodate incandescent lamp members.

I claim:

The ornamental design for a Christmas tree ornament or similar article, as shown and described.
