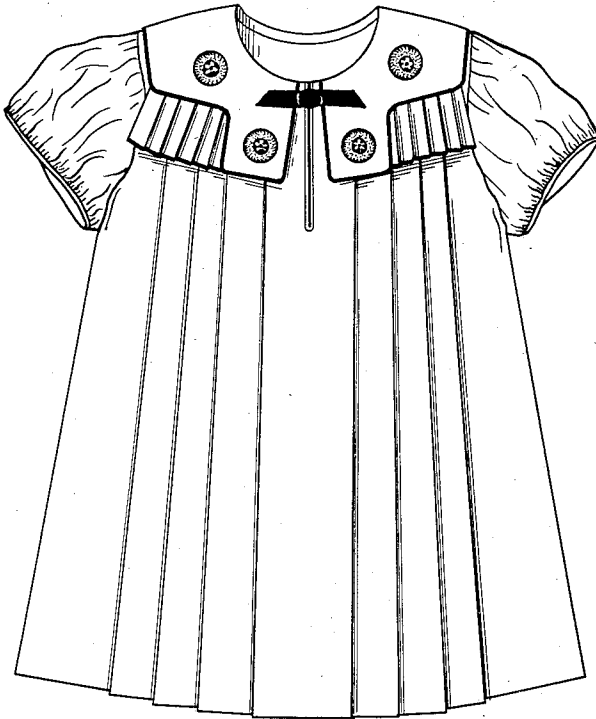

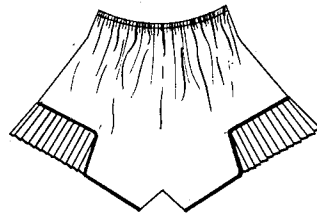
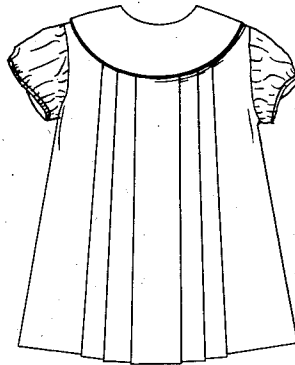

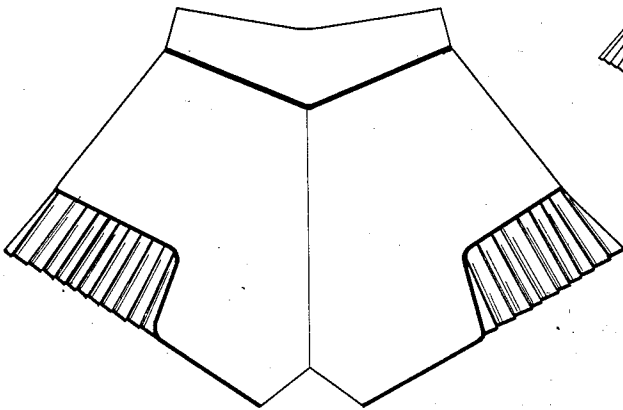

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Leo J. Goldberger, a citizen of the United States, residing at New York city, in the county and State of New York, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Dress and Panties Ensemble, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part thereof.
