The ornamental design for a mirror, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a front, left side perspective view of a mirror embodying my design, the front, right side perspective view is a mirror image;

FIG. 2 is a front view of the mirror of FIG. 1;

FIG. 3 is a left side elevational view of the mirror of FIG. 1;

FIG. 4 is a right side elevational view of the mirror of FIG. 1;

FIG. 5 is a top plan view of the mirror of FIG. 1;

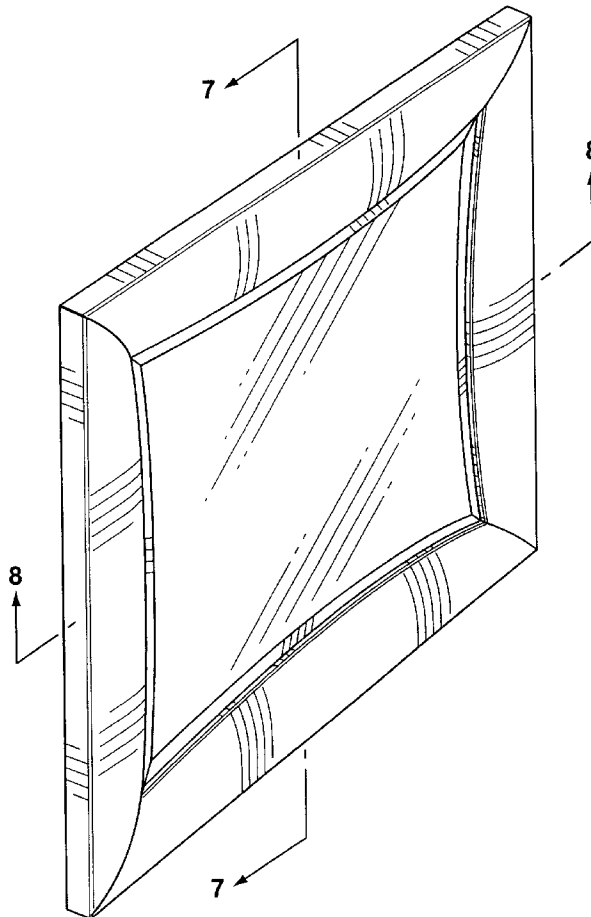
FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view of the mirror of FIG. 1;

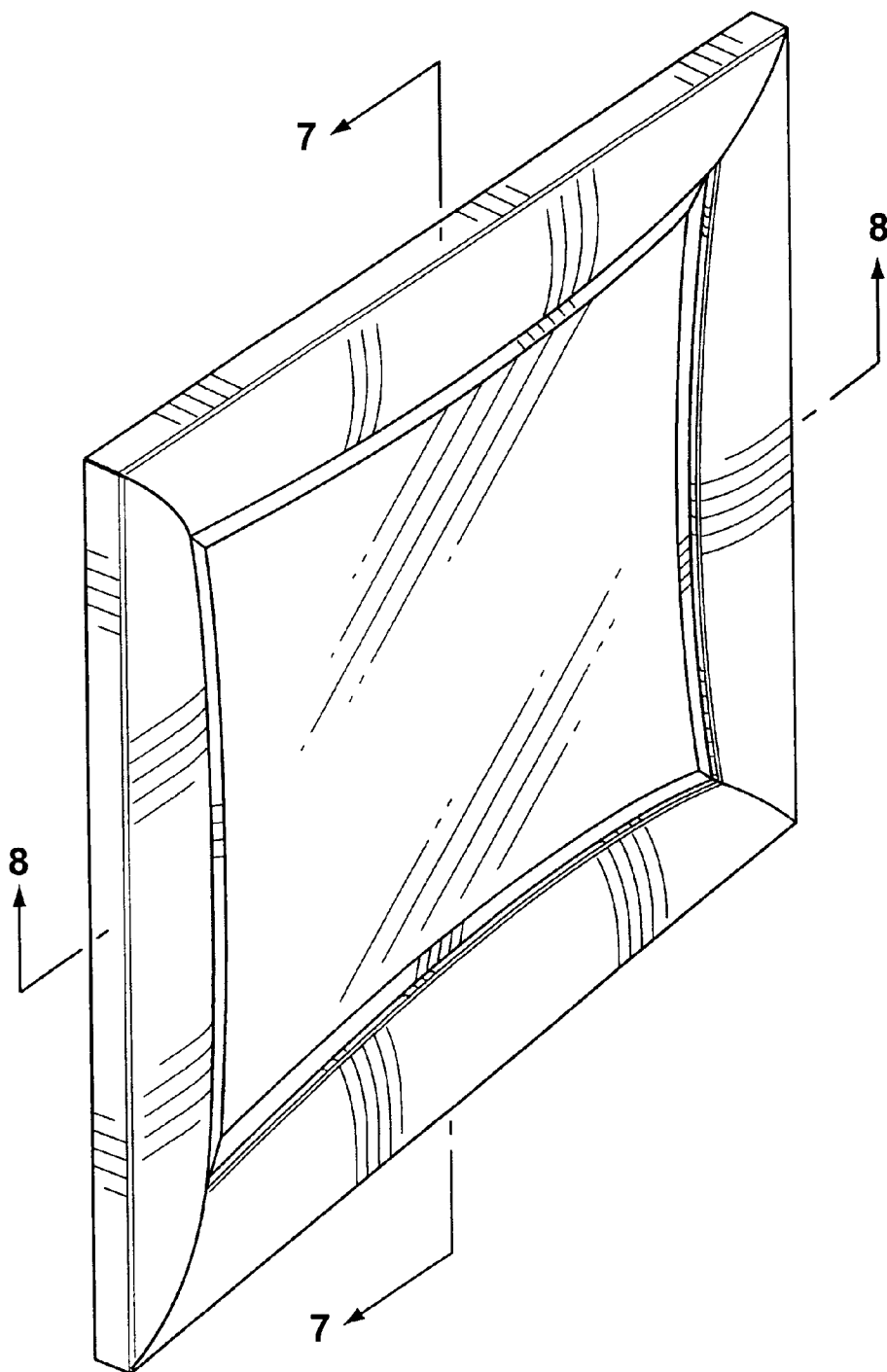
FIG. 7 is a cross-sectional view at 7—7 of the mirror in FIG. 1;
