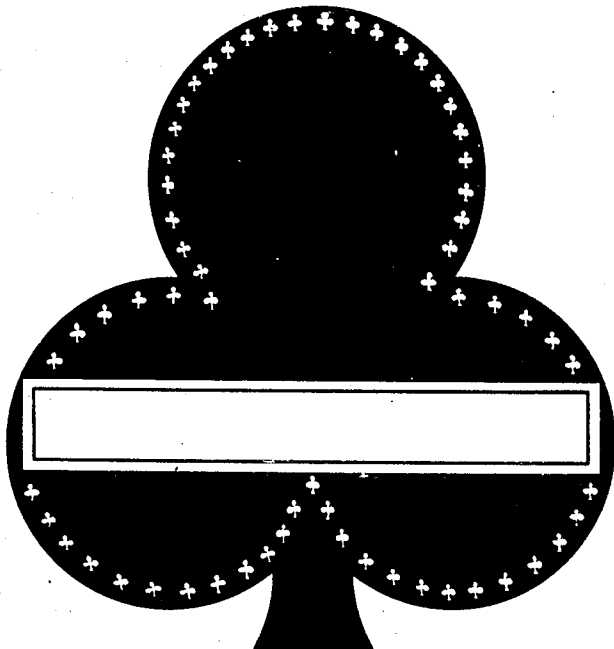

DESIGN FOR A DISPLAY HOLDER

Application filed December 22, 1930. Serial No. 38,058. Term of patent  $3\frac{1}{2}$  years.

*To all whom it may concern:*

Be it known that I, ALBERT DE CANIO, a citizen of the United States, residing at New York, in the county of New York, State of New York, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Display Holder (Case C), of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.
