

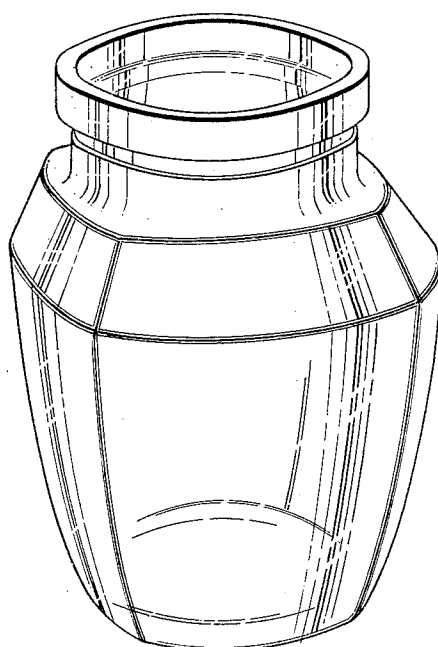

DESIGN FOR A JAR OR SIMILAR ARTICLE

Application filed October 14, 1931. Serial No. 41,388. Term of patent 14 years.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, THEODORE J. PIAZZOLI, a citizen of the United States, residing at McCoy Road, city of Connellsville, county of Fayette, State of Pennsylvania, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Jar or Similar Article, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part thereof.

The figure is a perspective view of a jar, showing my new design.

Dominant features of the design are a plu-

rality of convex sides extending upwardly and outwardly and corresponding inwardly inclined panels merging into a shoulder leading to the neck of the container, said inwardly inclined panels meeting said outwardly inclined panels and said shoulder at an angle to define arcuate lineations.

I claim:

The ornamental design for a jar or similar article as shown and described.
