## DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a credit card;

FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a left side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a right side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a top plan view thereof;


FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view thereof;

FIG. 8 is a perspective view of the credit card in a state in which the credit card is supported on the ground by its own stand:














