FIG. 6 is a rear elevation view thereof;

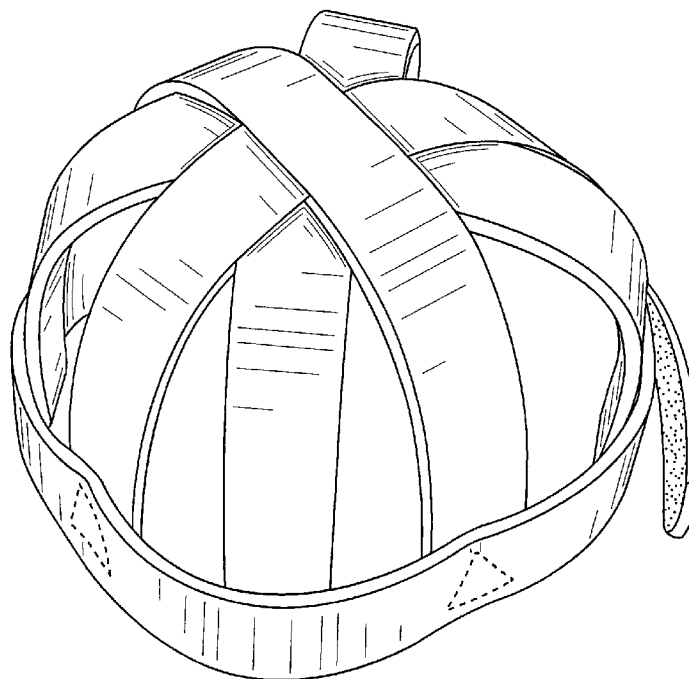
FIG. 7 is a front elevation view thereof;

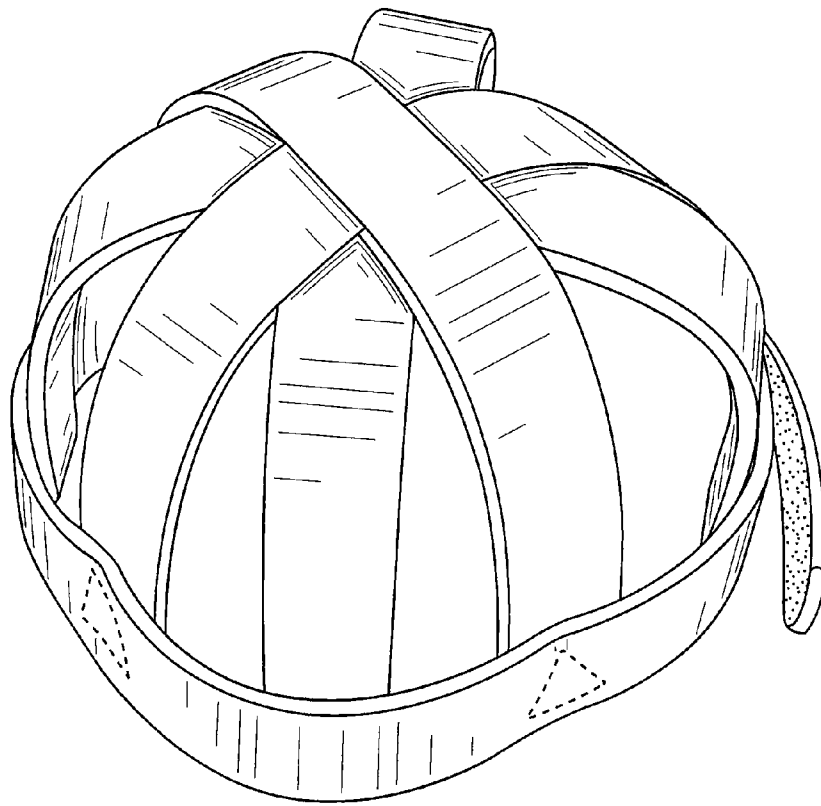

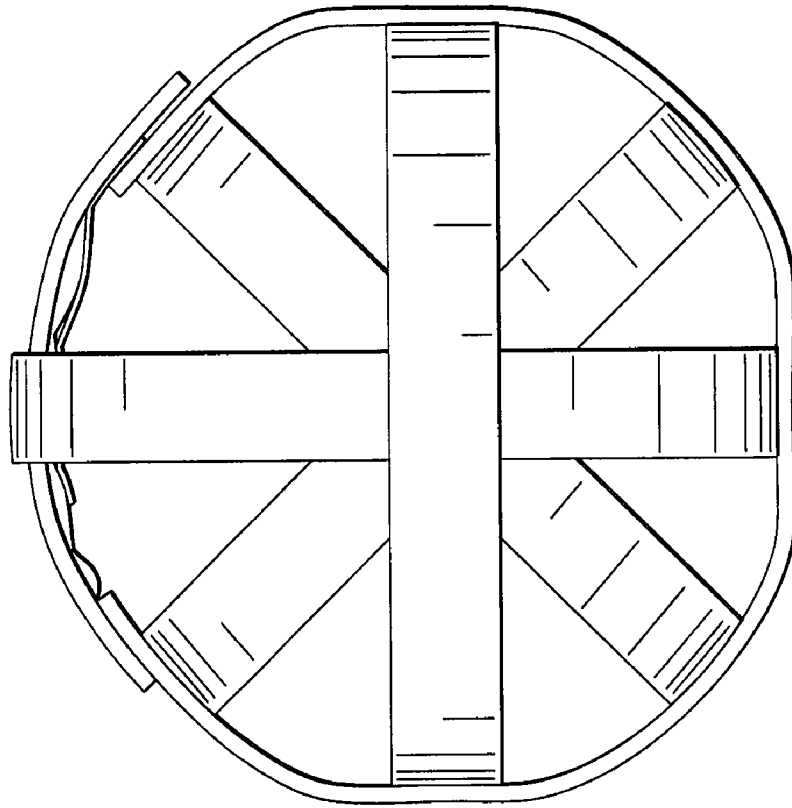

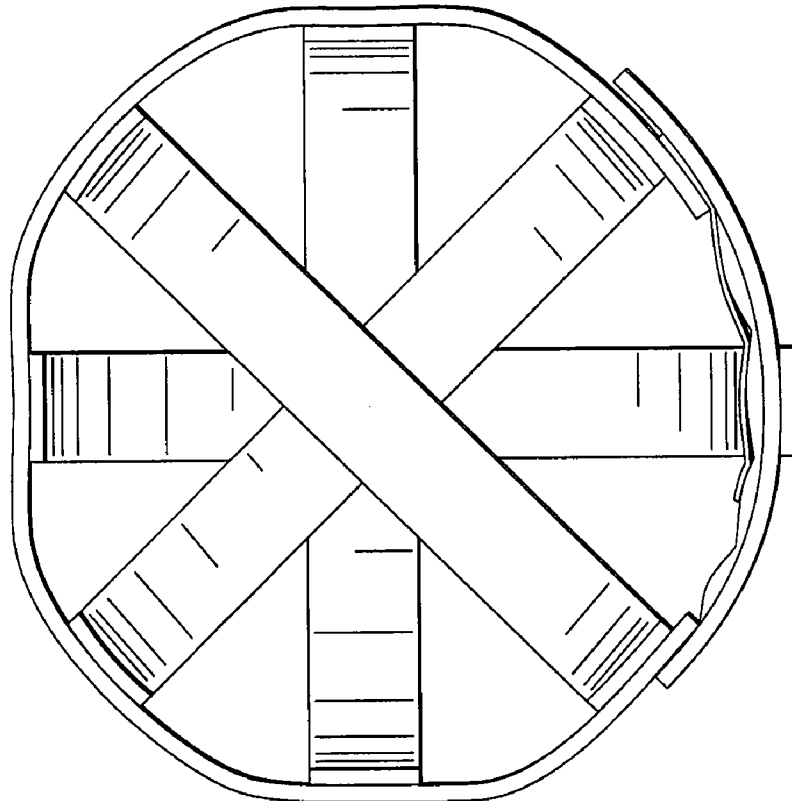

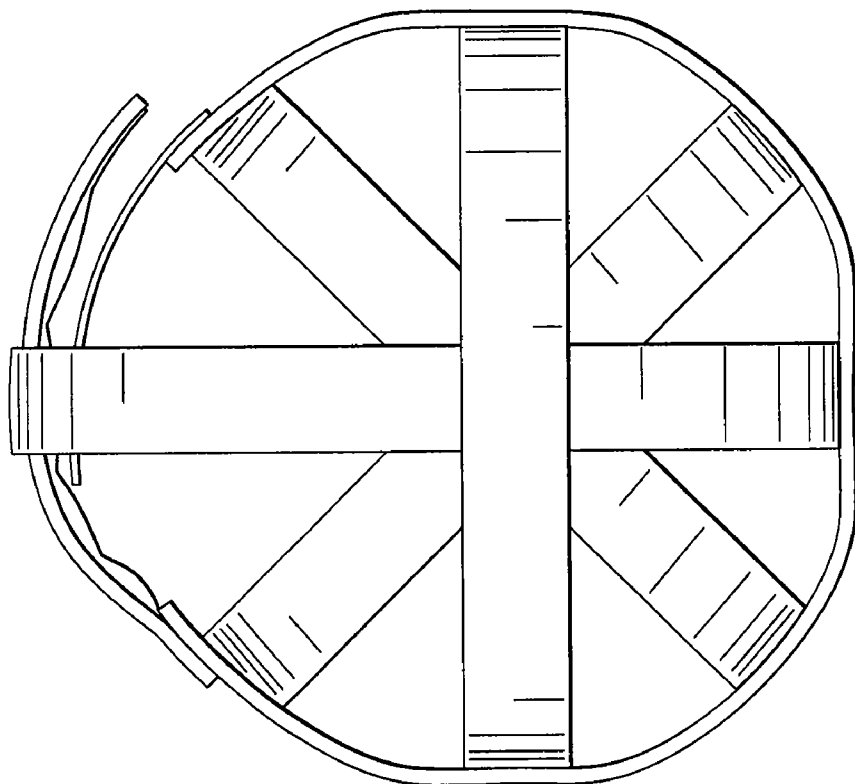

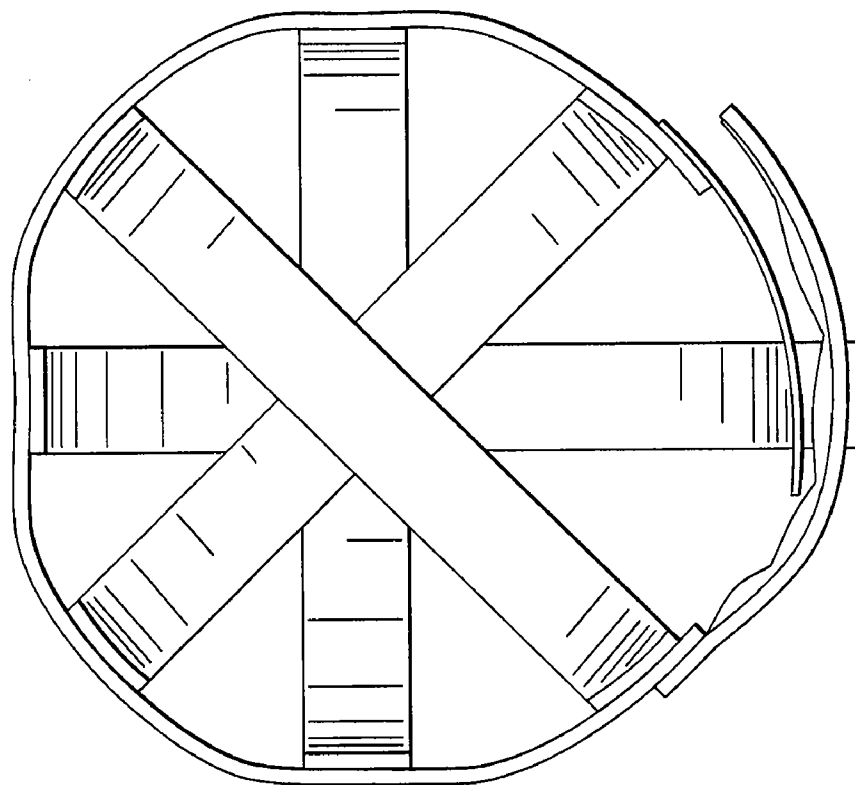

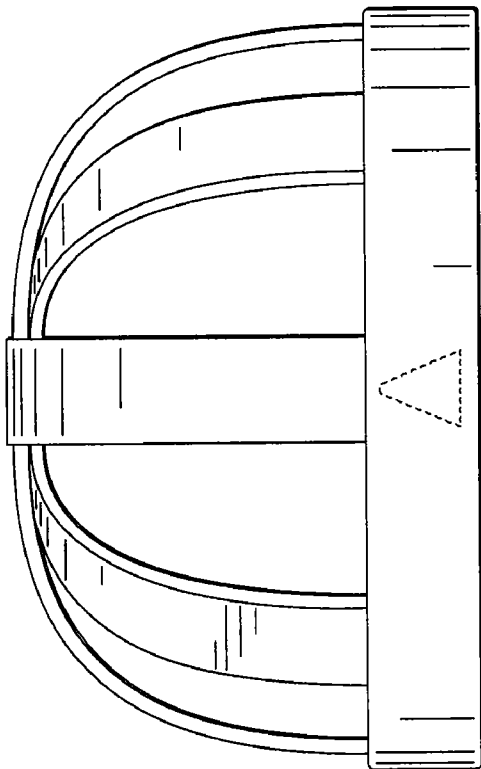

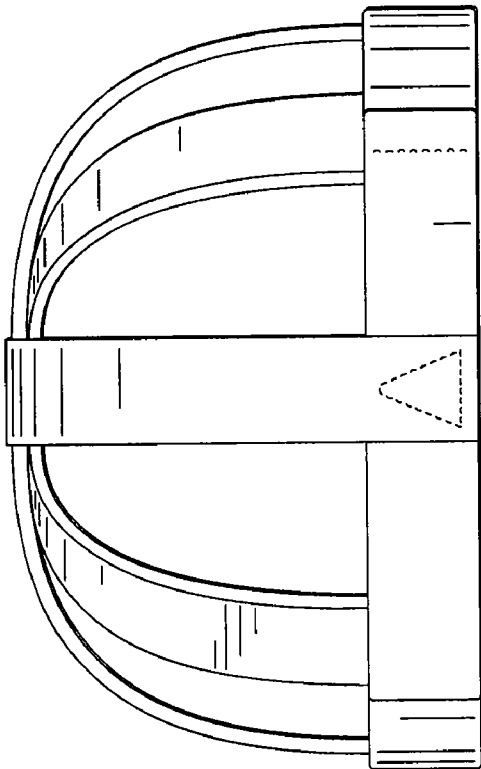

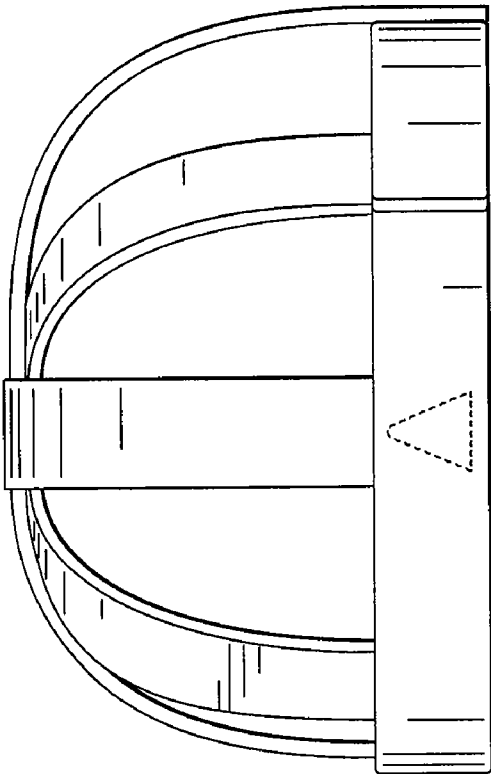

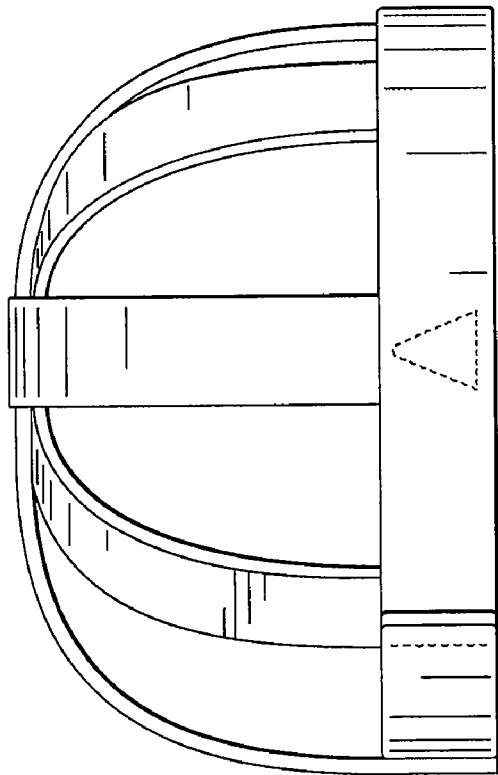
