









To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Carl Bramming, a citizen of the United States, residing at Nashville, county of Davidson, and State of Tennessee, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Reflecting Mantle Lantern, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawings forming a part thereof, in which:

Fig. 1 is a front perspective view of a reflecting mantle lantern showing my new design;
Fig. 2 is a rear perspective view thereof;
Fig. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof;
Fig. 4 is a front elevational view thereof;
Fig. 5 is a top plan view thereof;
Fig. 6 is a side elevational view thereof; and

Fig. 7 is an elevational view showing the side opposite that shown in Fig. 6.
