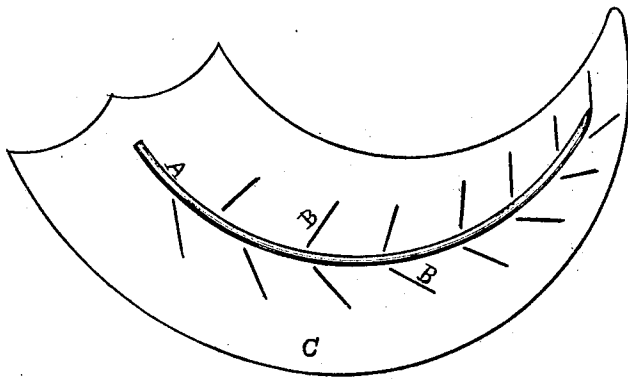
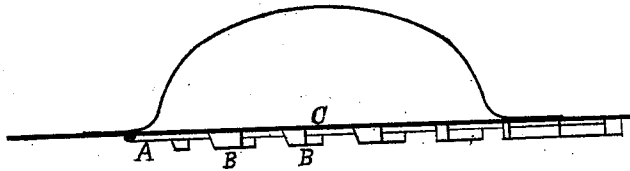

IMPROVED PIE-STAMPER AND CUTTER.

The Schedule referred to in these Letters Patent and making part of the same.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, ALLEN HAWKES, of Providence, in the county of Providence, in the State of Rhode Island, have invented a new and improved Combined Mode of Stamping and Cutting the Tops of Pies; and I do hereby declare that the following is a full and exact description thereof, reference being had to the accompanying drawings and to the letters of reference marked thereon.

The nature of my invention consists in the combination of a stamp and set of cutters affixed to one base, which stamp and cutters operate together and at the same time, and which, pressed upon the tops of pies, will stamp and cut them ready for use.

To enable others to make and use my invention, I will proceed to describe its construction and operation.

I construct the base and handle of my stamp and cutters in any of the known forms, but, in order for the

operator to save time in stamping and cutting, and also to have the stamping and cutting more ornamental on the tops of pies, I affix a stamp as shown at A in the accompanying drawing, and a set of cutters, B B, to the base C, the stamp and cutters being affixed in any desired form. Thus the stamp and cutters being combined and affixed to one base, will, when used, stamp and cut at the same time, whereby saving in time and labor will be realized.

Having described my invention,

What I claim as new, and desire to secure by Letters Patent, is—

The stamp A, in combination with the cutters B B, as and for the purpose set forth.
