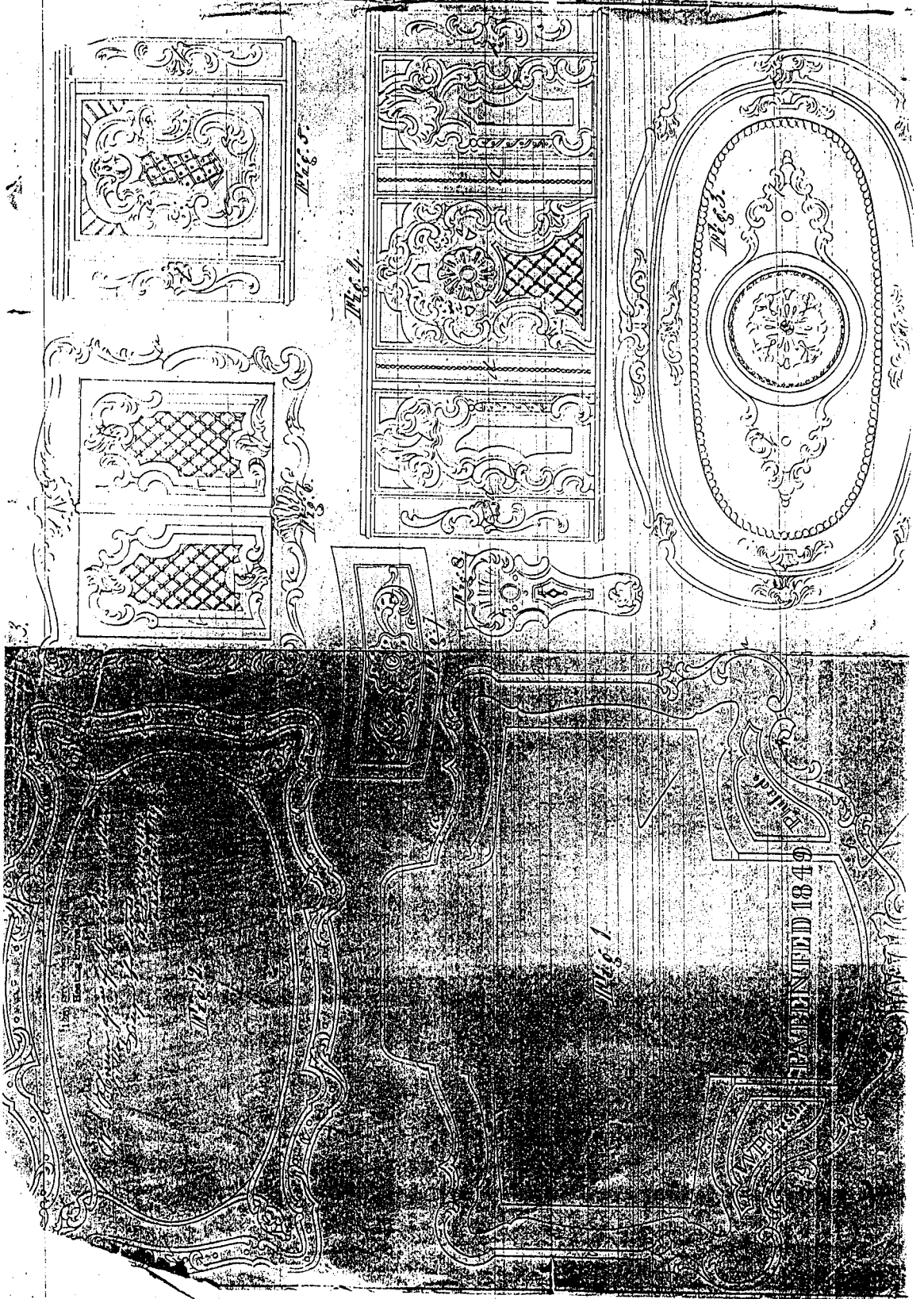

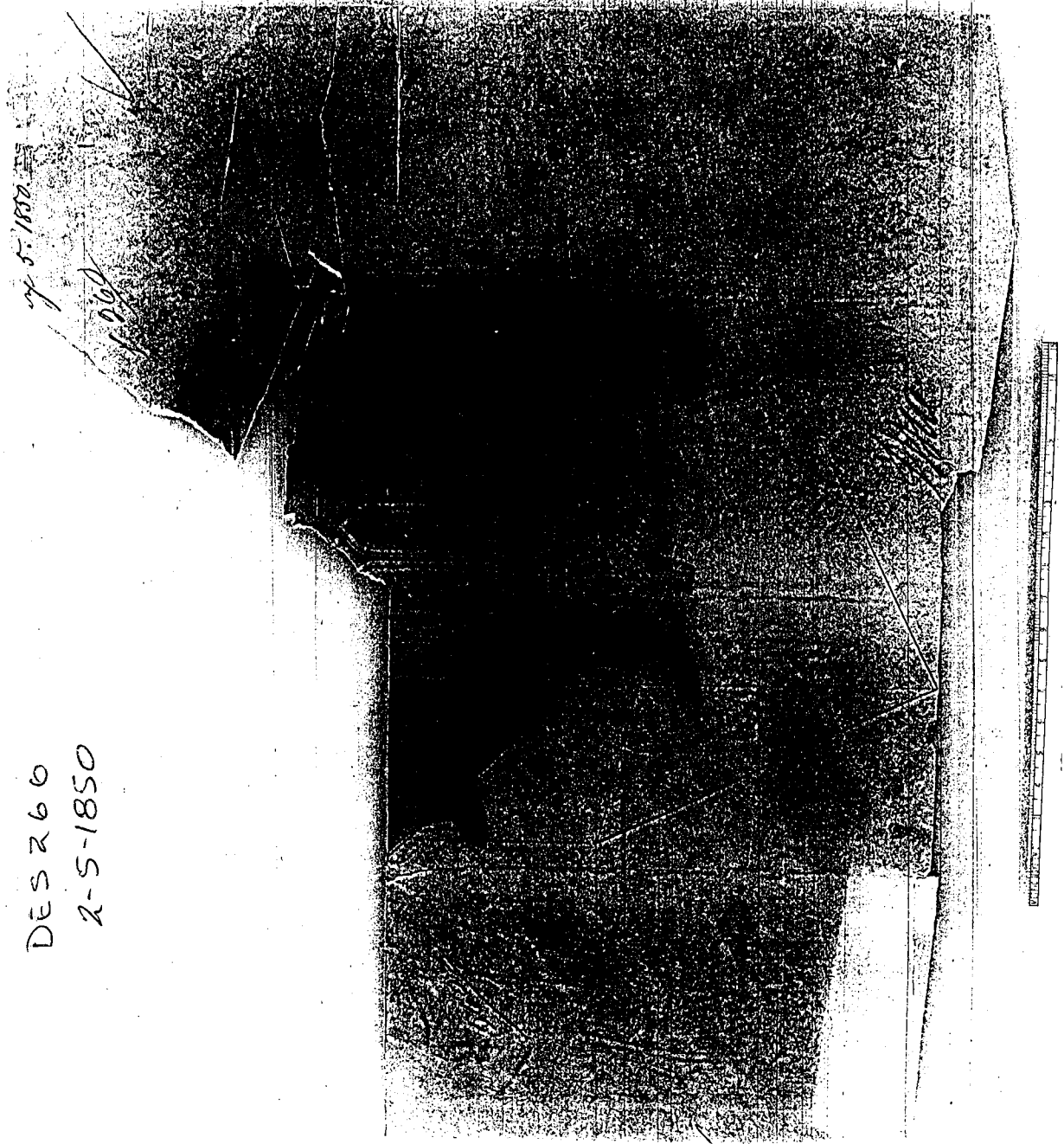

The schedule referred to in these Letters Patent and making part of the same

To whom it may concern,

Be it known, that we, Joseph G. Lamb, & Conrad Harris, both of Cincinnati, Hamilton County, State of Ohio, have invented and produced a new and ornamental Design for cooking Stoves, and we hereby declare that the following is a full & exact description, and that the accompanying drawings are a correct representation thereof. To Wit, Those parts of Drawings marked Letter A represent the Feet. - Letter B, Ornamented Base extended around the stove, Letter C, Gothic panels on each oven door & on the front (under the fire bottom), with a vase, & flowers in each as shown, with arches ornamented as shown - Letters D, are Gothic panels, with arches ornamented same as the others on the front and end fire doors & on the panel opposite to the end fire doors, with a vase and flowers in each as shown - Letter E, is cornice ornamented as shown. - Letter G, Panel on each side of stove with three ornamented arches over the top. The whole forming a complete ornamental Design for a cooking Stove.
