FIG. 7 is a top, front and right side perspective view thereof.

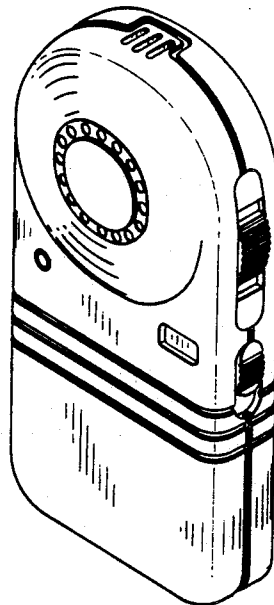

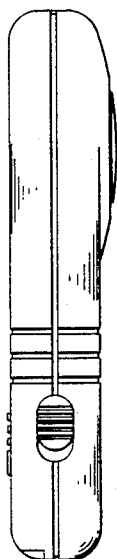

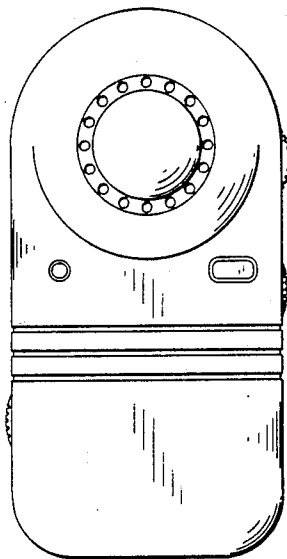

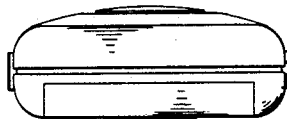

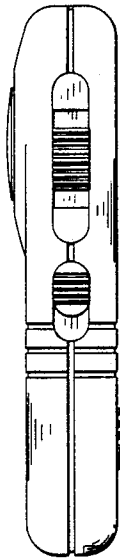

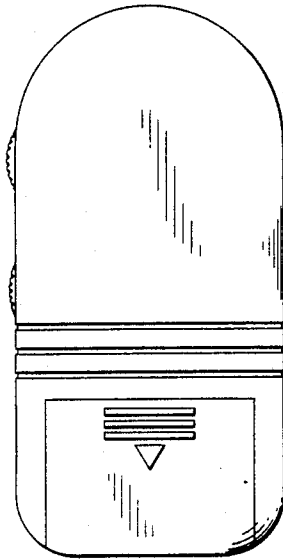
