The ornamental design for a multi-purpose support, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top, front, and left side perspective view of a multi-purpose support showing my new design, the broken-line disclosed of a portion of a flag pole being for illustrative purpose only and forming no part of the claimed design;

FIG. 2 is a right side elevational view thereof, showing a portion of the adhesive affixing means revealed;

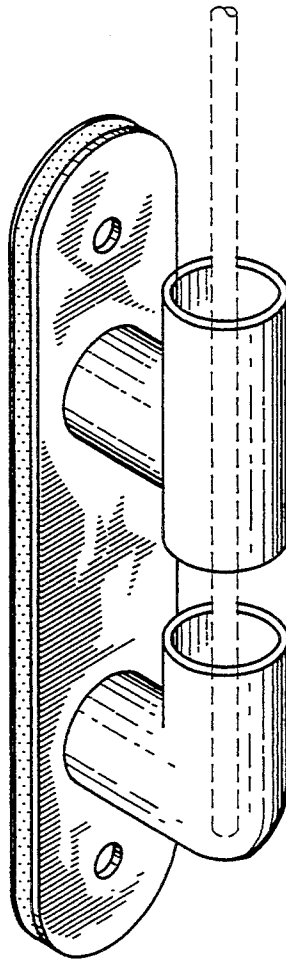
FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof, showing a portion of the adhesive affixing means revealed;

FIG. 4 is a horizontal cross-sectional view thereof, taken along line 4—4 of FIG. 2;

FIG. 7 is a front elevational view thereof.



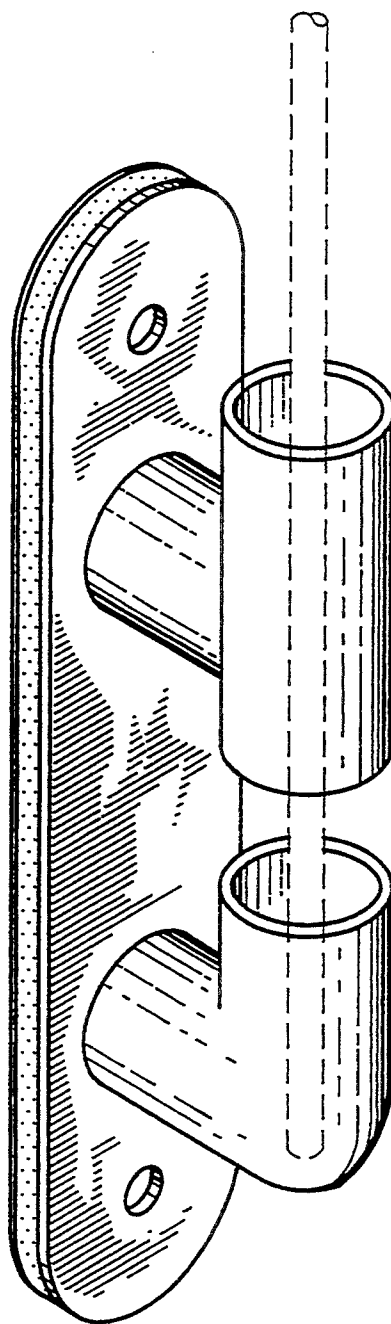

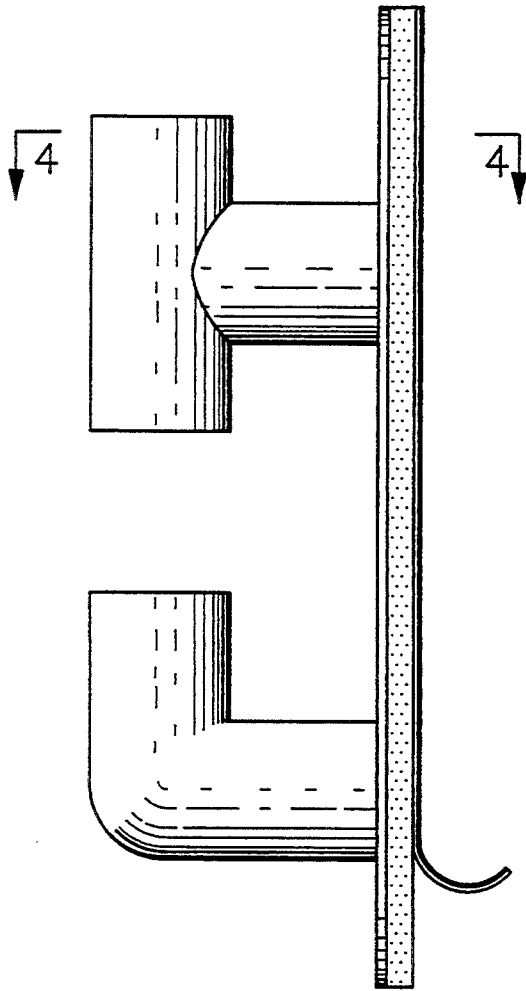

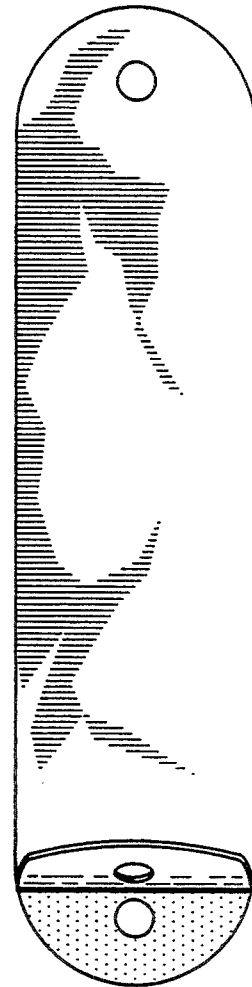

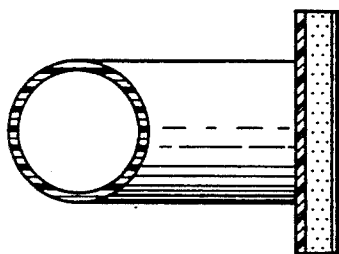

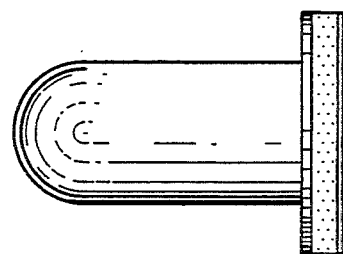

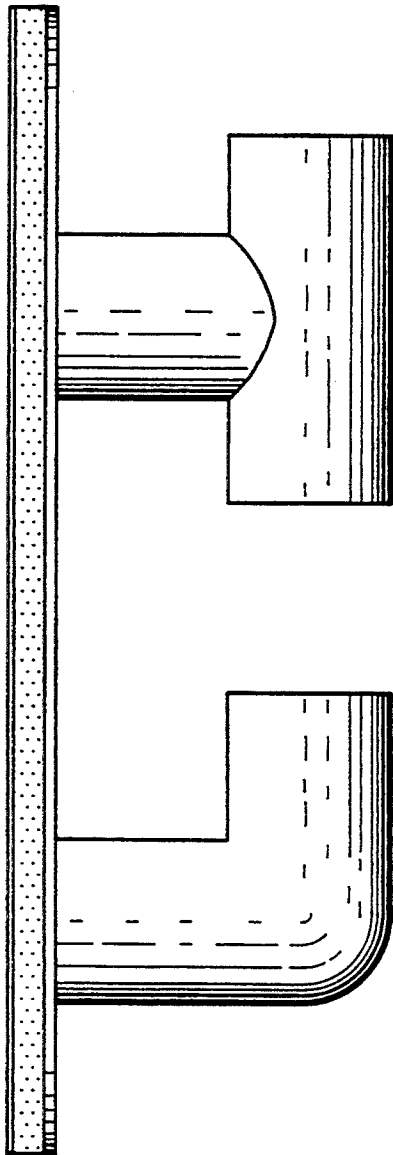

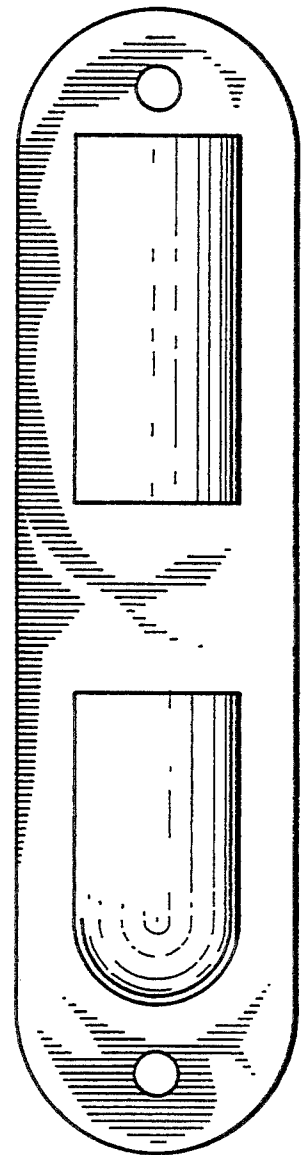
