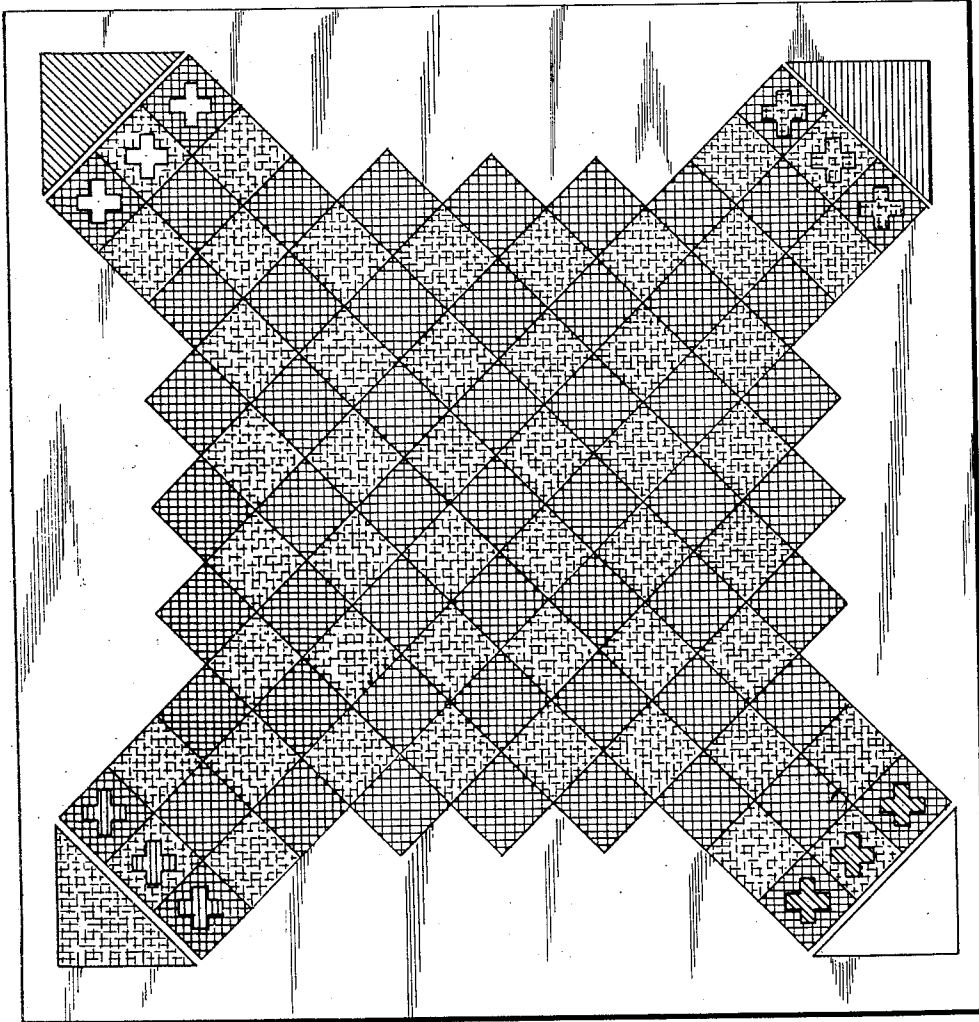

DESIGN FOR A GAME BOARD

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Charles H. Taylor, a citizen of the United States, residing at Springfield, in the county of Hampden, and Commonwealth of Massachusetts, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Game Board, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.

Fig. 1 is a plan view of a game board showing my new design; and

Fig. 2 is an edge view of the game board shown in Fig. 1.
