

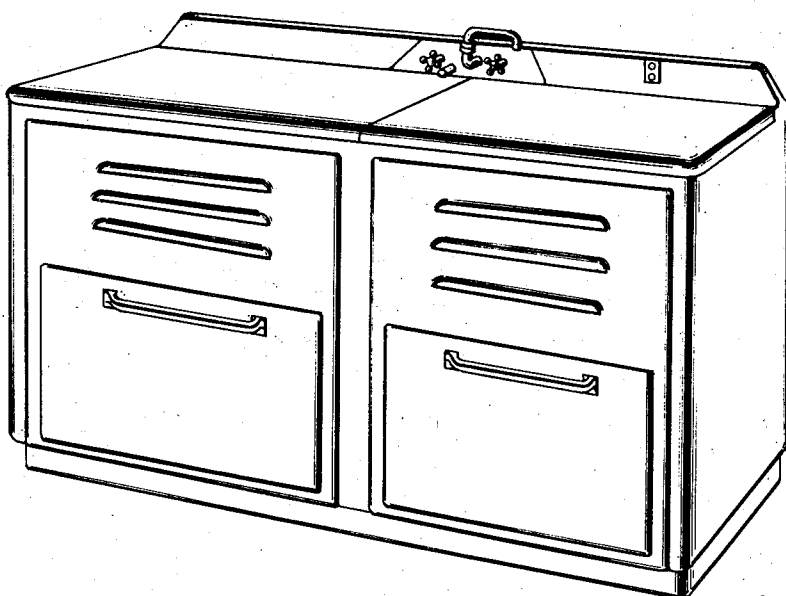

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that we, Edward S. Baer and Guy W. Krick, citizens of the United States and residents, respectively, of Elsinore, in the county of Riverside, and Ontario, in the county of San Bernardino, State of California, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Laundry Cabinet, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.

The figure is a view in perspective of a laundry cabinet embodying our design, the side or end of the cabinet not shown being like the side or end illustrated.
