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(54) **Wall starter tie.**

(57) A wall starter tie for connecting a new wall to an existing wall which comprises a spirally shaped rod,

preferably arranged in the form of a 'U' with rectangular corners.

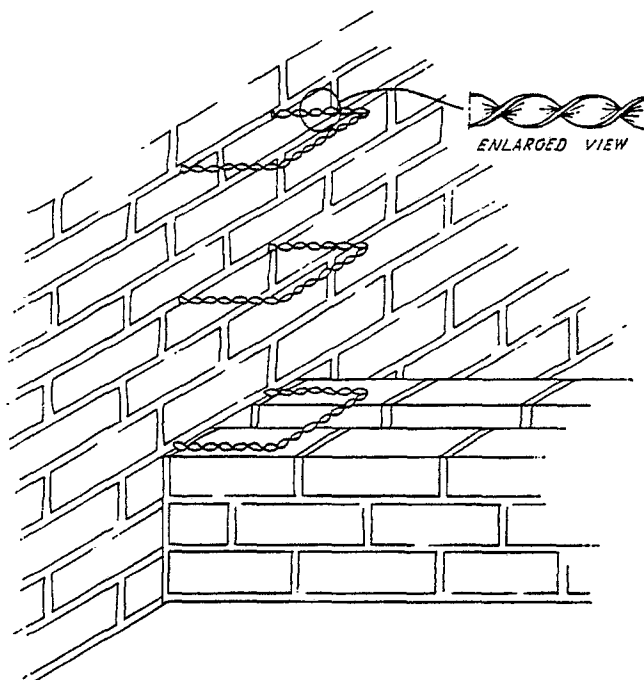
