

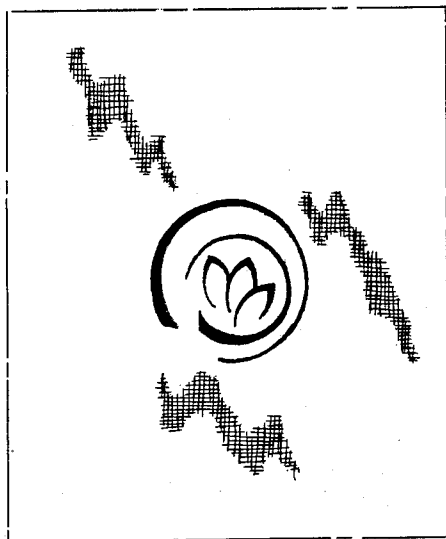

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Dan Rubenberg, a citizen of the United States, residing at 100 Riverside Drive, in the Borough of Manhattan, city of New York, in the county of New York and State of New York, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for Embroidered Textile Fabric or Similar Article, of which following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.
