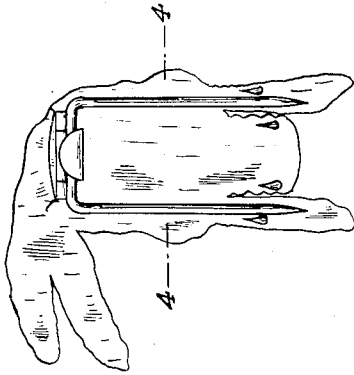

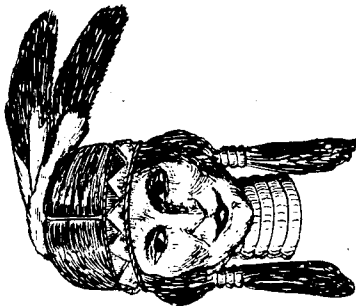

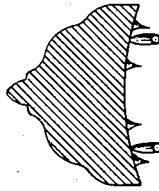
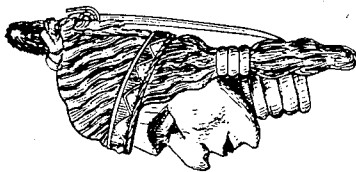

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Georges Albert Julien Bezault, a citizen of the French Republic, residing at Juvisy-sur-Orge, Seine-and-Oise Department, France, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Clip, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.

Fig. 1 is a side elevation of a clip showing my new design.

Fig. 2 is a front elevation of the same.

Fig. 3 is a rear view of the same.

Fig. 4 is a horizontal sectional view of the same, taken along line 4—4 of Fig. 3.
