DESCRIPTION

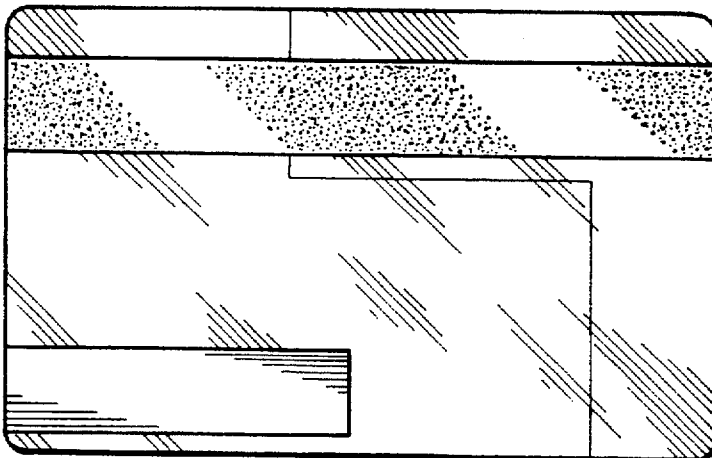
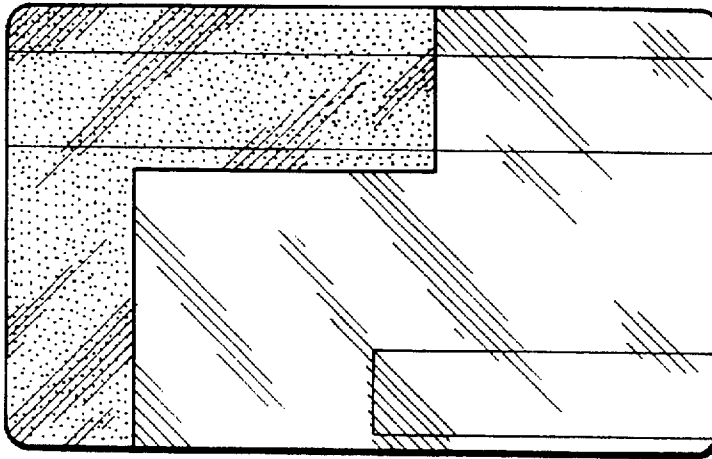
FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a partially transparent card with opaque machine-readable and signature-receiving stripes showing my new design;

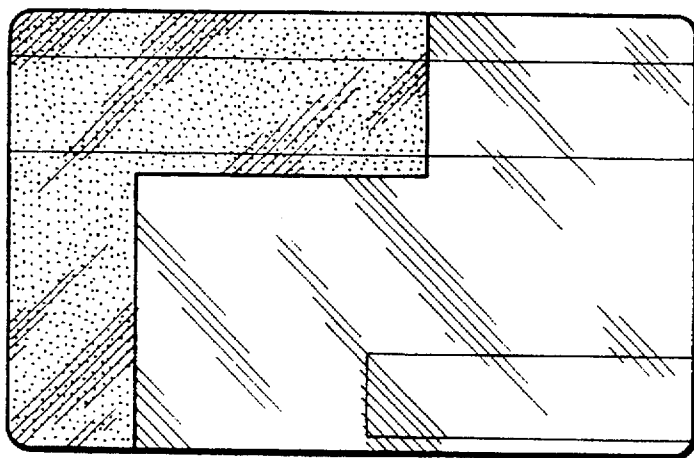

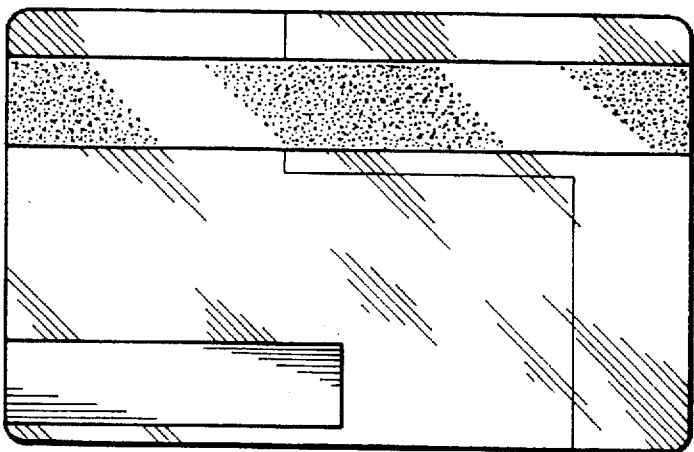

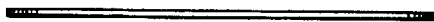
