FIG. 15 is a left side view thereof;

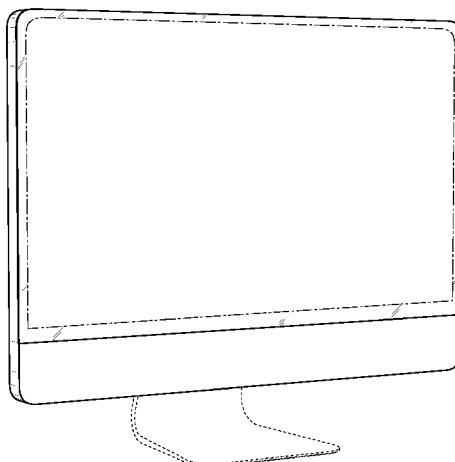
FIG. 16 is a top view thereof;

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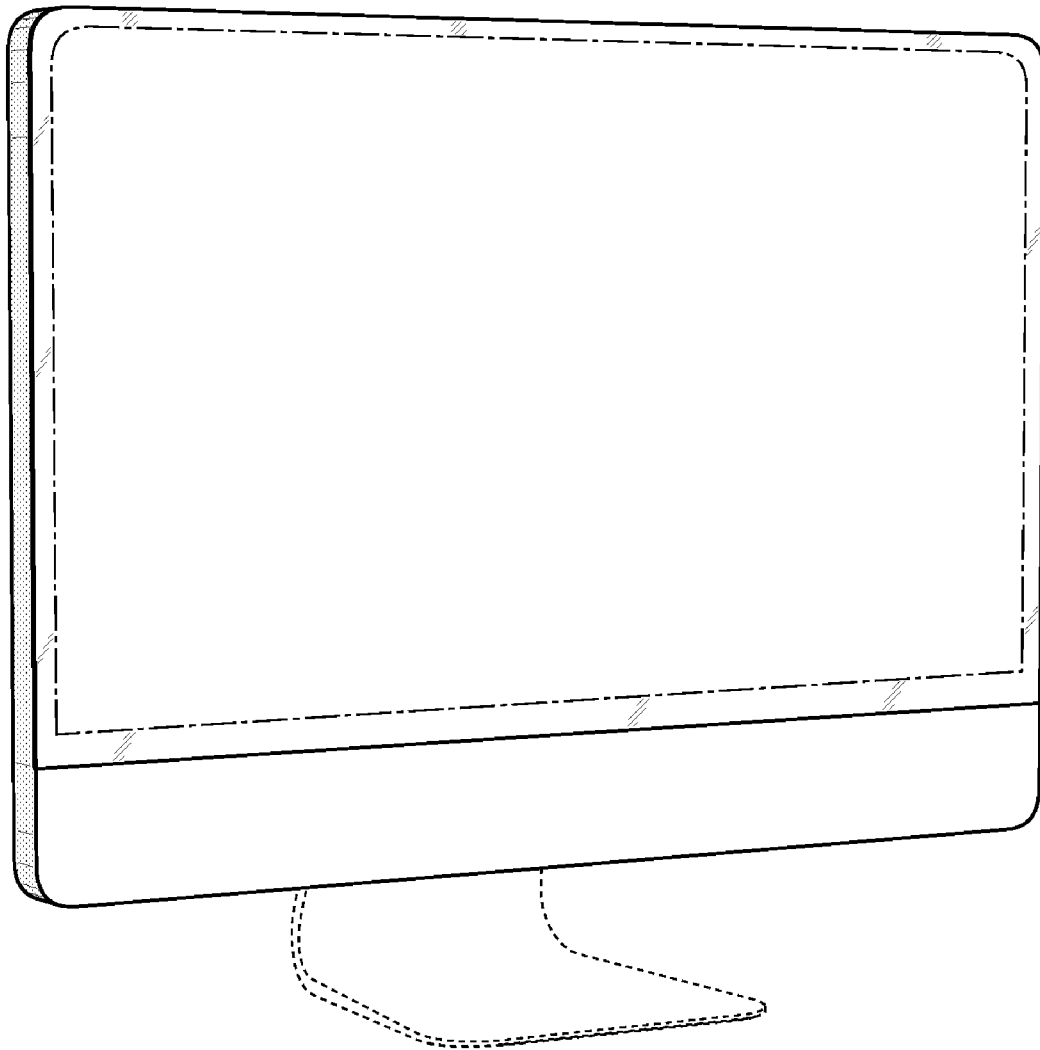

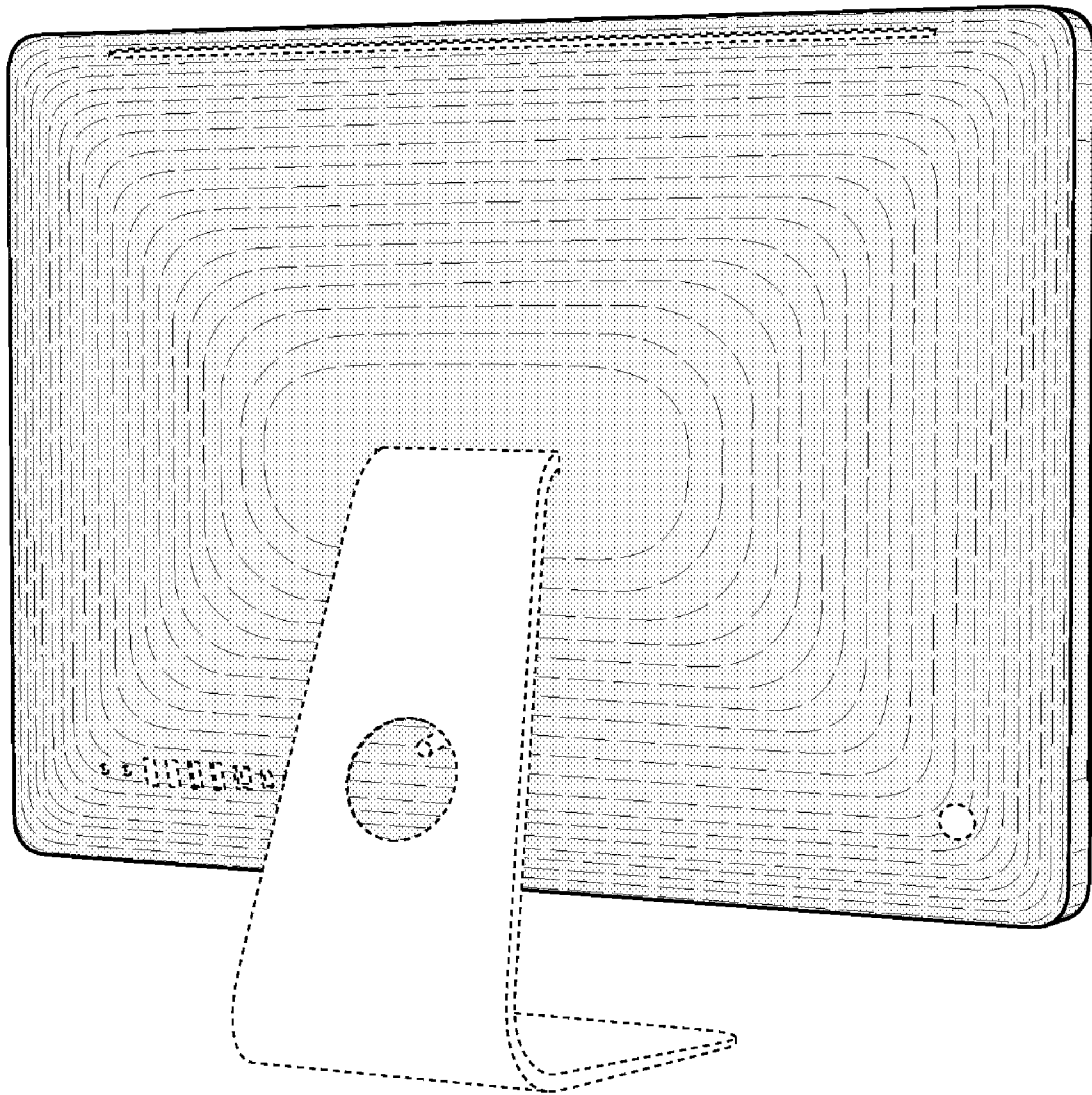

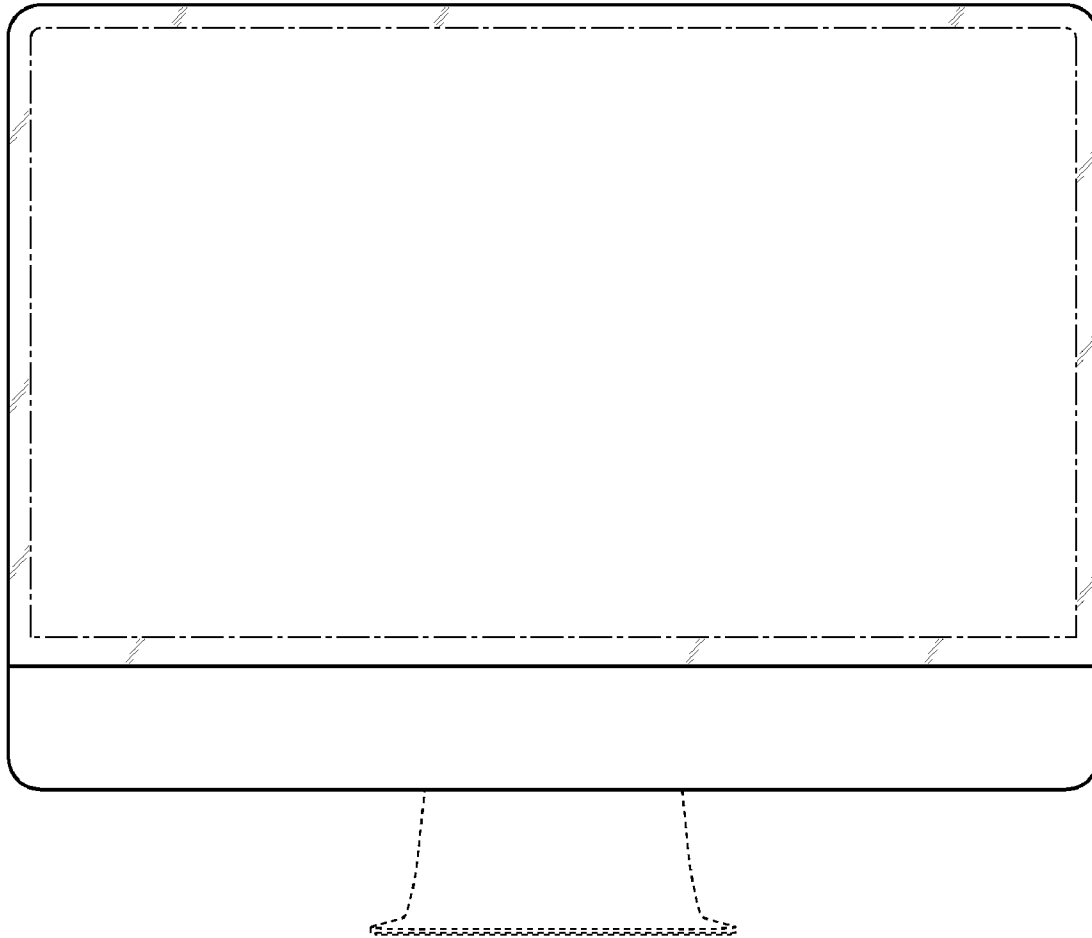

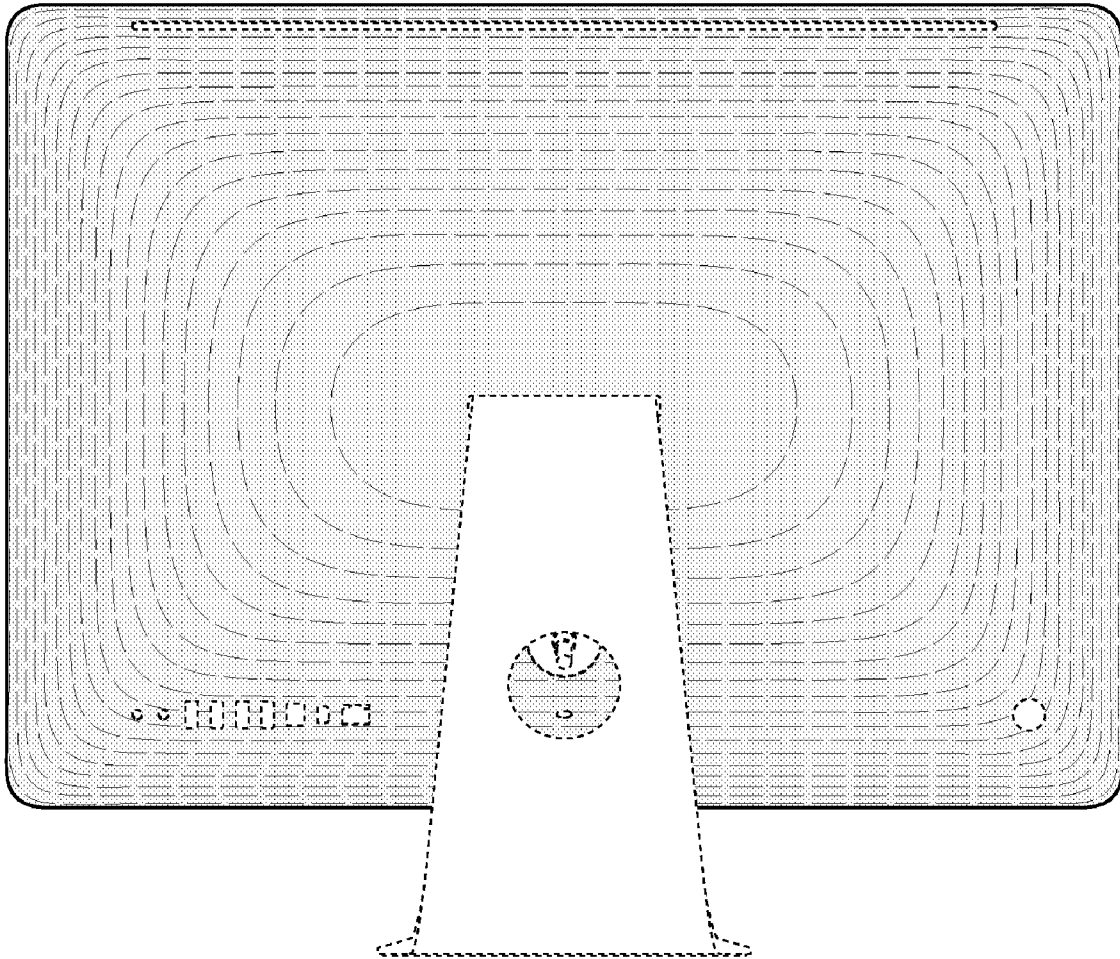

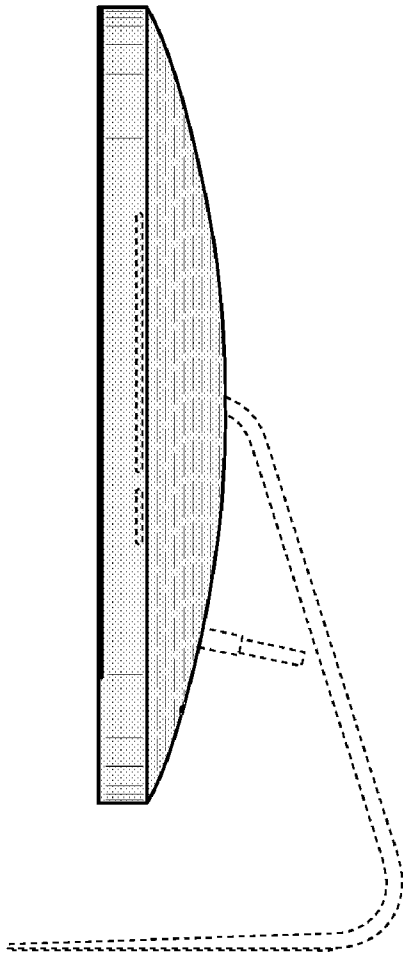

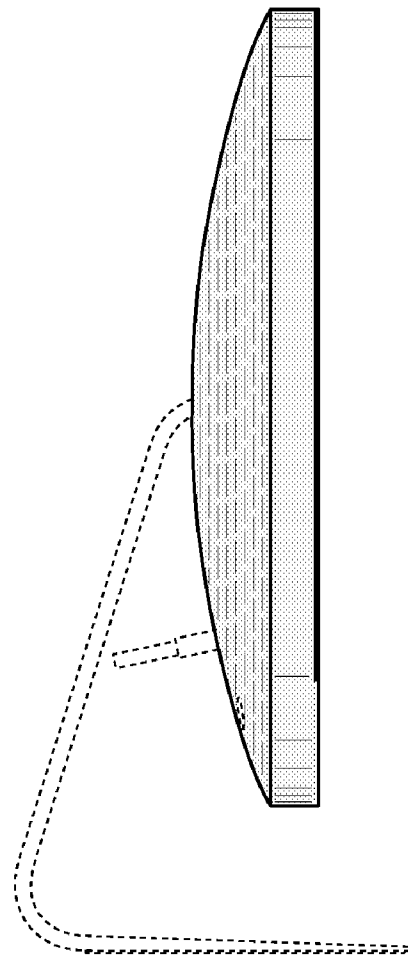

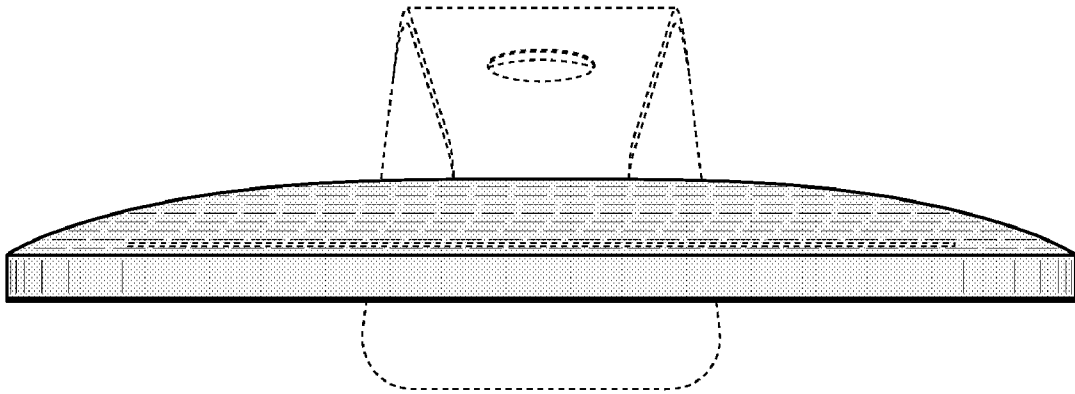

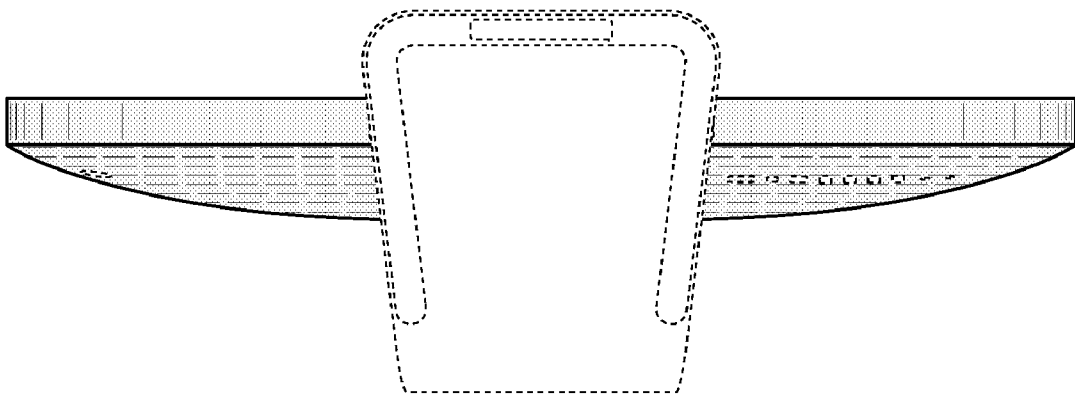

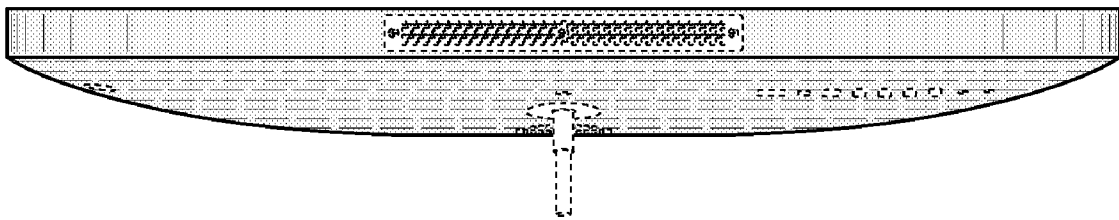

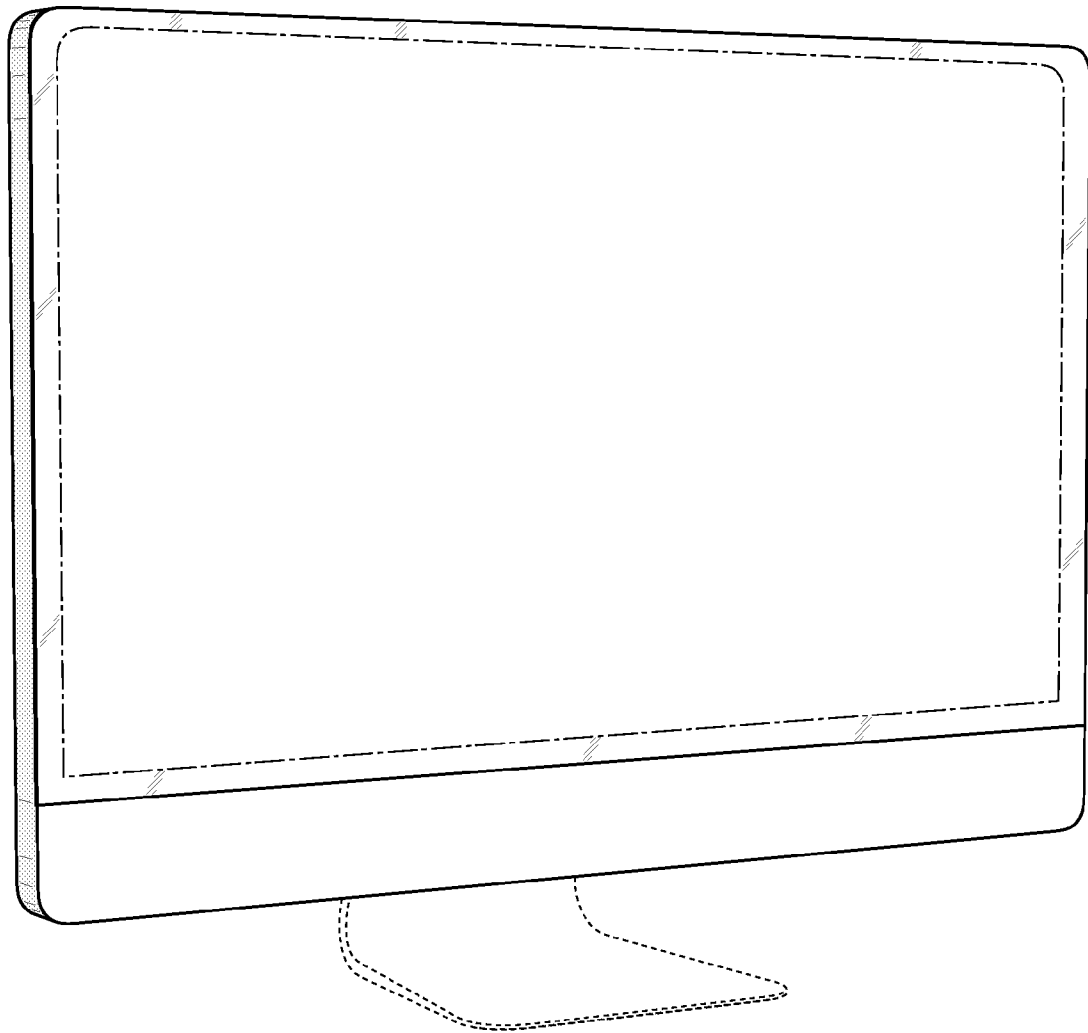

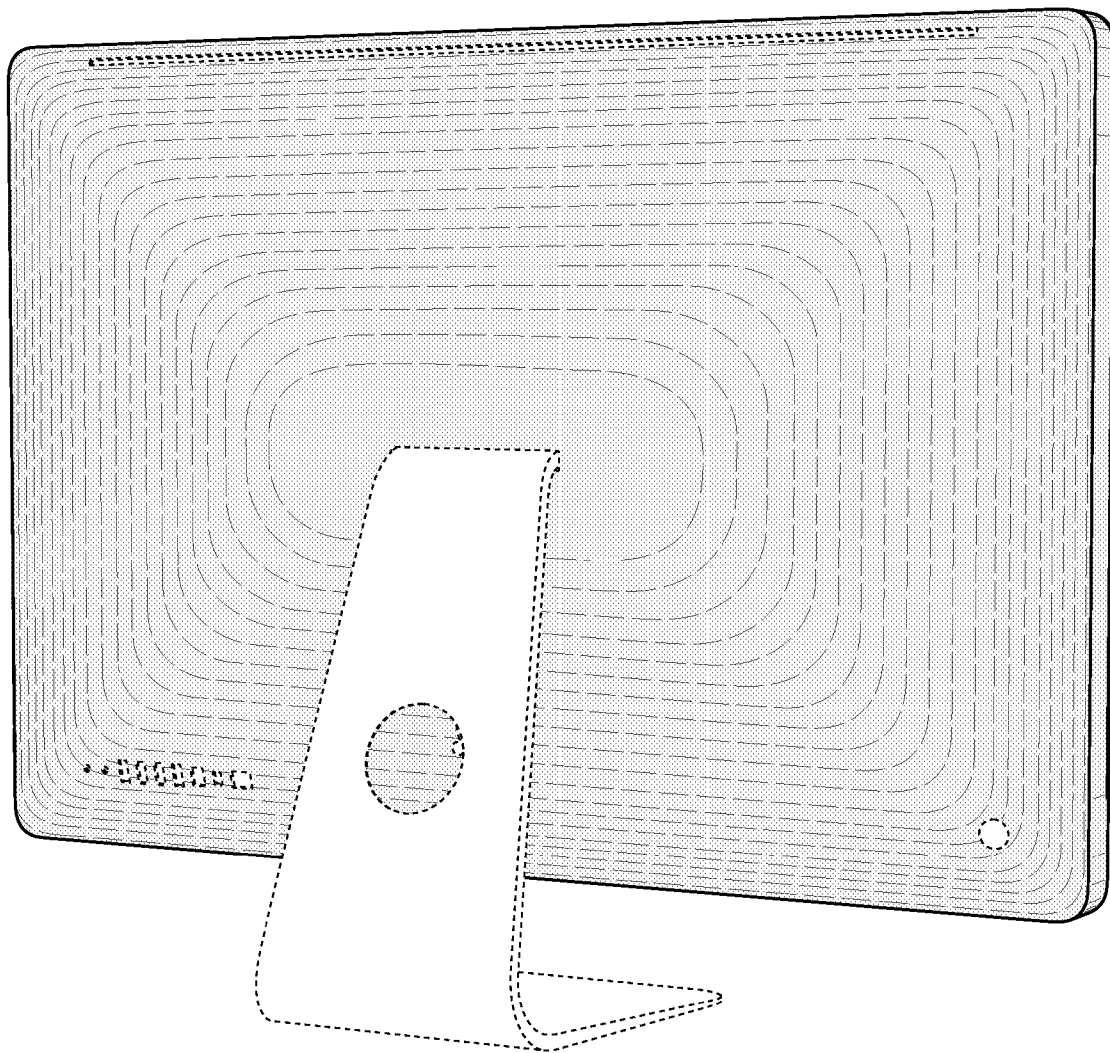

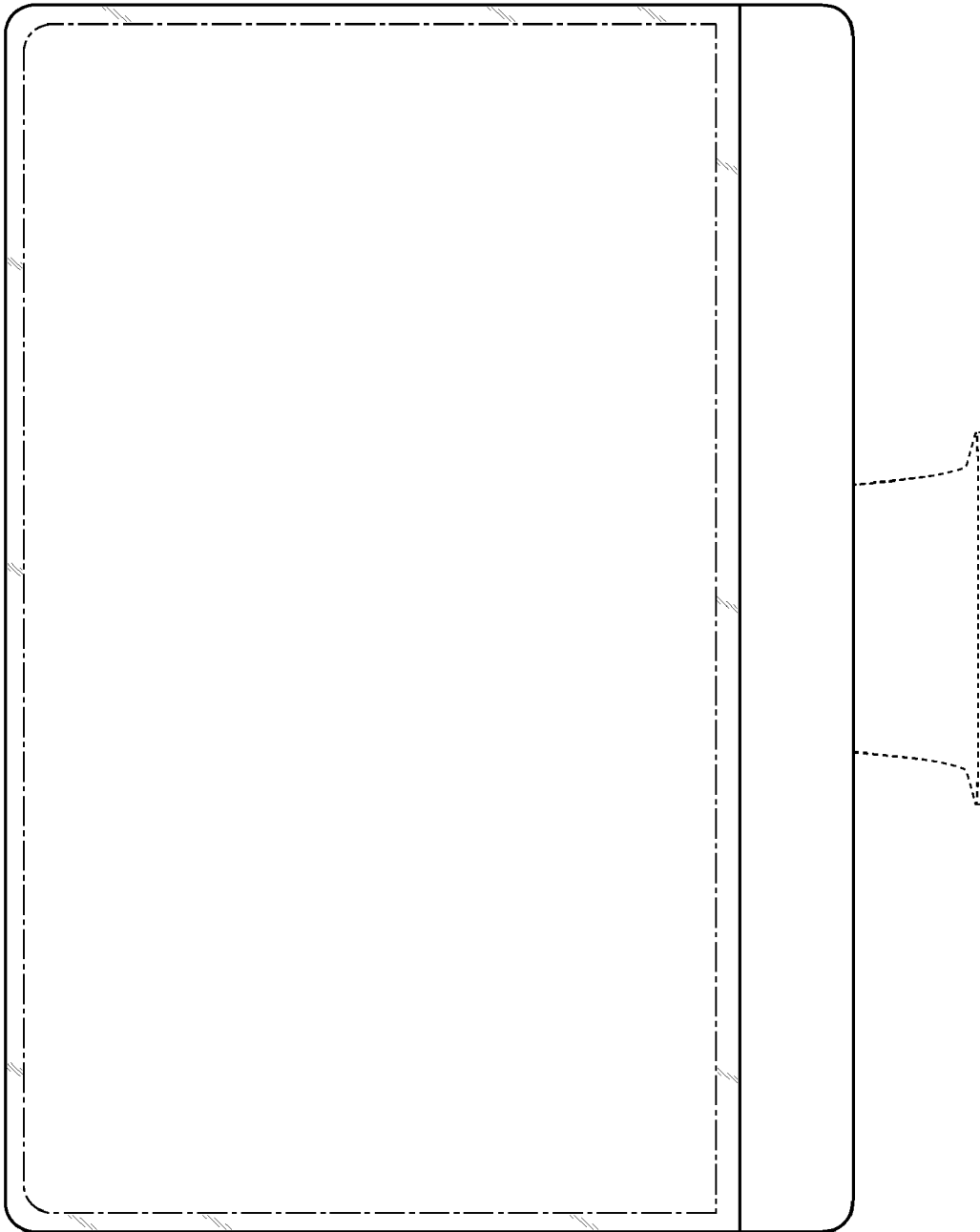

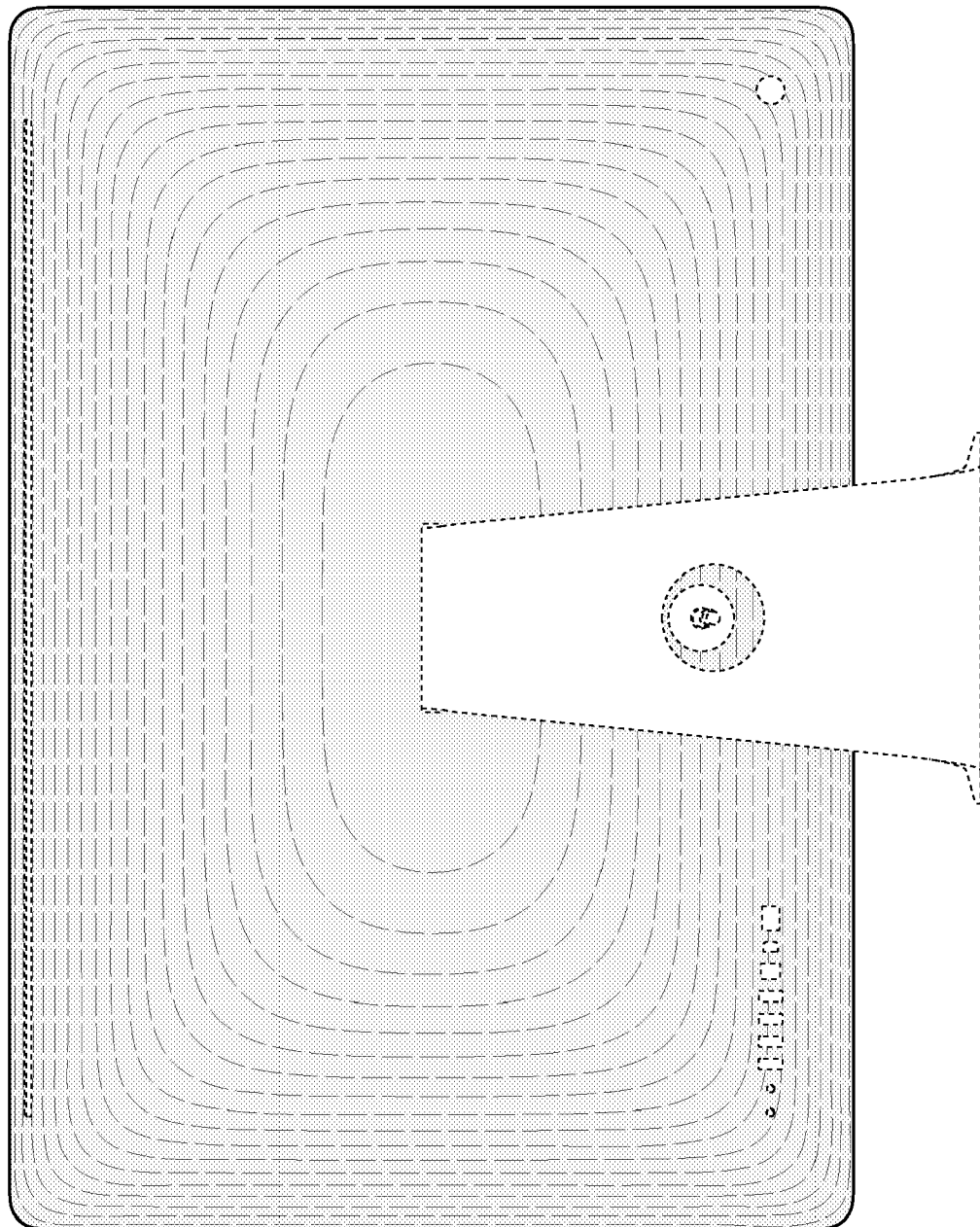

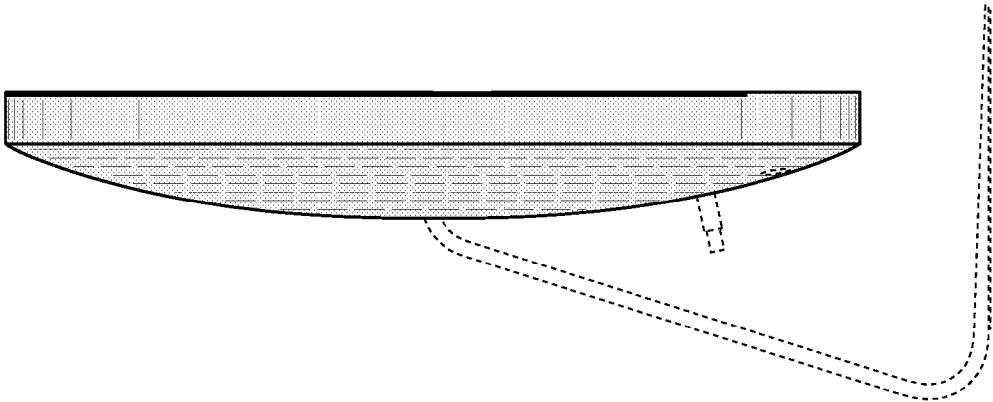

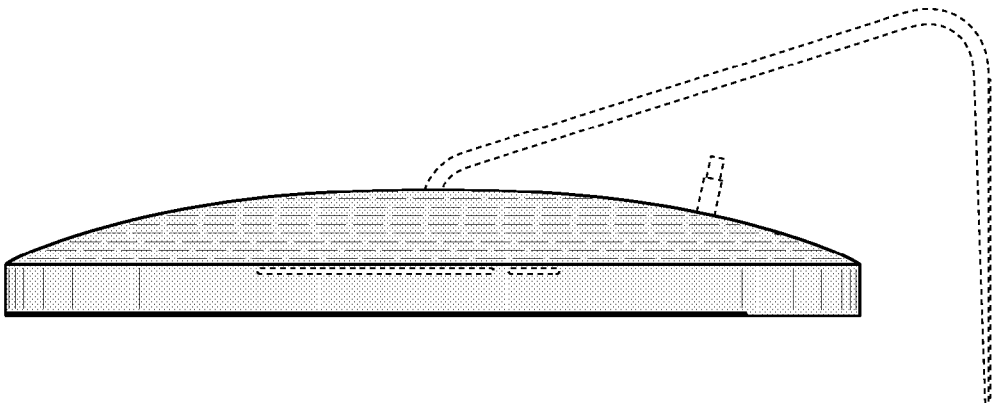

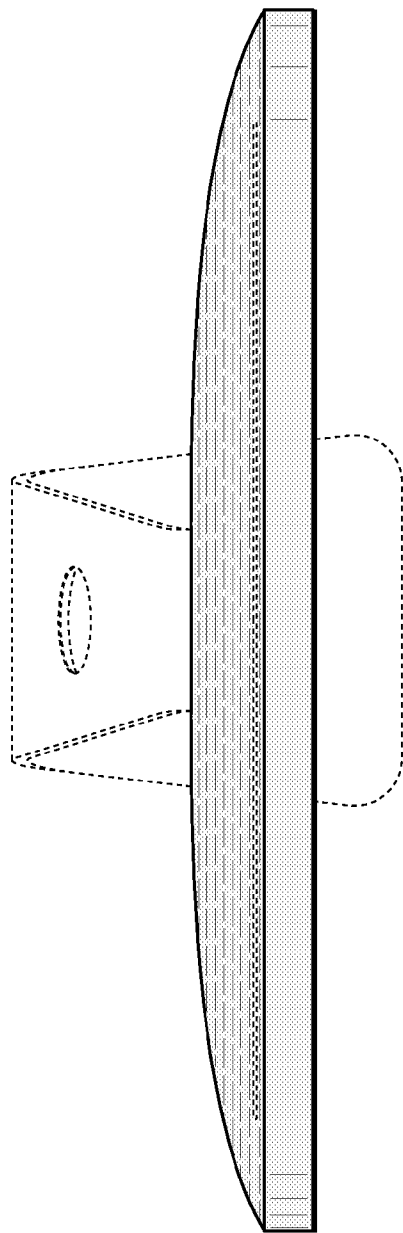

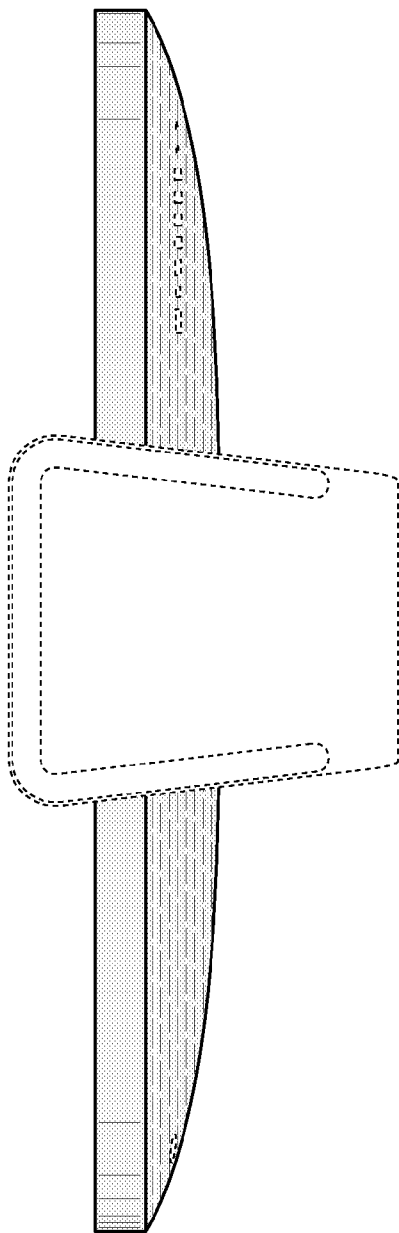

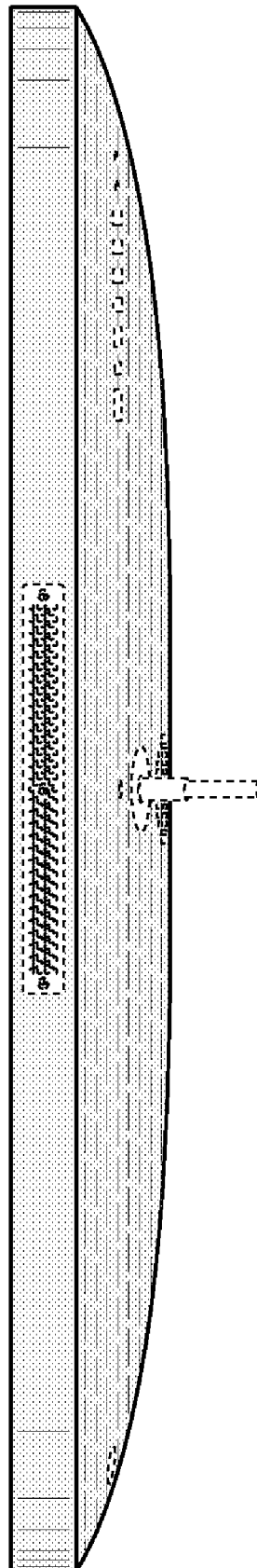
