## (57) CLAIM

The ornamental design for a diaper bag/backpack with removable shoulder bag, as shown and described.

#### DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a diaper bag/backpack with removable shoulder bag showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a right side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 5 is left side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a rear elevational view thereof;

FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view thereof;

FIG. 8 is a perspective view thereof, showing the extended strap of the shoulder bag;

FIG. 9 is a right side elevational view of the removable shoulder bag shown in FIG. 8;

FIG. 10 is a front elevational view of FIG. 9

FIG. 11 is top plan view of FIG. 9;

FIG. 12 a left side elevational view of FIG. 9;

FIG. 13 is a rear perspective view of FIG. 9; and,

FIG. 14 is a bottom plan view of FIG. 9.

The broken lines shown on the surface of the article throughout the views are understood to represent stitching.

The claim is directed to the appearance of a diaper bag/backpack with a removable shoulder bag. The shoulder bag is shown separately for the purpose of showing aspects of the design that are not apparent from the other views, and for the convenience of illustration.
