





DESIGN FOR A RECEIVING BLANKET

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Bertha Braun Friedman, a citizen of the United States of America, residing in New York city, in the Borough of Bronx, county of Bronx, and State of New York, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Receiving Blanket, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawings, forming part thereof, wherein,

Figure 1 is a front view of a receiving blanket, showing said blanket in a folded position.

Figure 2 is a rear view of the receiving blanket shown in Figure 1.

Figure 3 is a plan view of the receiving blanket shown in Figure 1 spread out.
