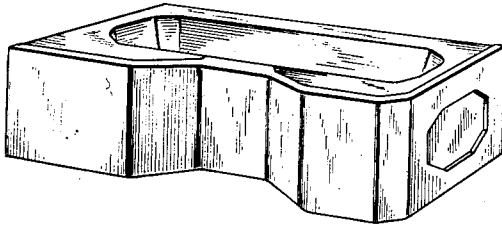

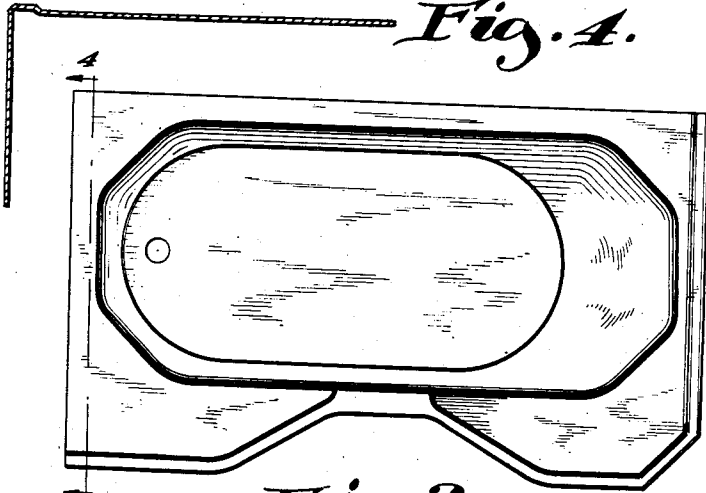

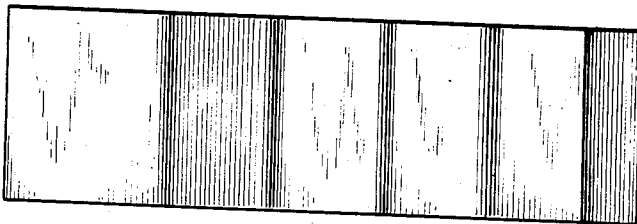

DESIGN FOR A BATHTUB

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Louis H. Goeltz, a citizen of the United States, residing at Milwaukee, in the county of Milwaukee and State of Wisconsin, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Bathtub, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part thereof, and in which:

Figure 1 is a perspective view of a bathtub showing my new design;

Figure 2 is a top plan view of the bathtub shown in Figure 1;

Figure 3 is a view thereof in front elevation; and

Figure 4 is a view in transverse vertical cross section taken on line 4—4 of Figure 2.
