The schedule referred to in these Letters Patent, and making part of the same

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, William Resor, of Cincinnati in the County of Hamilton, and State of Ohio, have invented or produced a new ornamental Design for a Franklin Stove, and I do hereby declare the following to be a full, clear and exact description thereof, reference being had to the annexed drawings, making part of this Specification, in which

Fig. 1. represents the front of the stove, and the top of the hearth.

Fig. 2. is a section through the front at the line x, x, fig. 1.

The contour, both of the fire space and of the exterior outline is that of an elevated semi circular arch, bordered, by half round beads (a, b) the intervening space (c,) being slightly depressed as shown in the section.

The crown of the arch is decorated with a blossom (d,) surrounded by tendrils and scroll work, (e) (f) spreading over the adjacent depression between the beads, and over a hood which projects downwards from the inner bead.

A half round bead (g,) imparts a finish to the foot of the stove front, the space immediately above this being further ornamented by a scroll h.

I claim as new and of my Invention the ornamental design and configuration of stove plate, substantially as herein described and illustrated.
