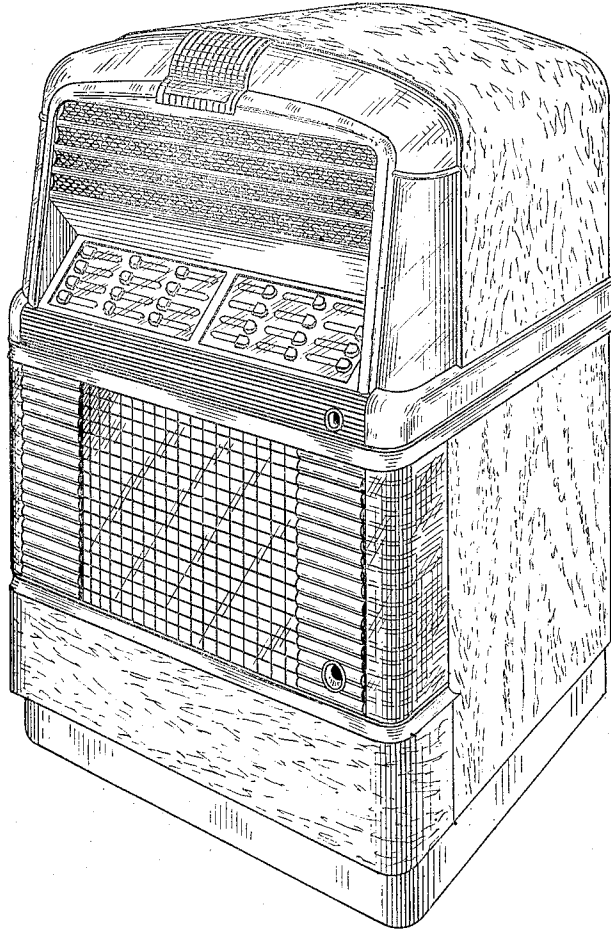

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Ernest F. Thomson, a citizen of the Dominion of Canada, residing at Tuckahoe, Westchester County, New York, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Phonograph Cabinet, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.

In the drawing, the single figure is a perspective view of a phonograph cabinet embodying my new design.

Both sides of the design are the same.
