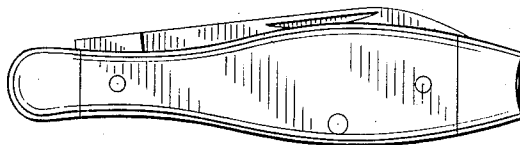

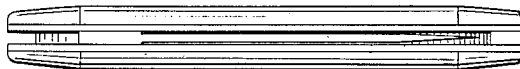

DESIGN FOR A POCKET KNIFE OR SIMILAR ARTICLE

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that Felix A. Mirando, a citizen of the United States and resident of Providence, in the county of Providence and State of Rhode Island, has invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Pocket Knife or Similar Article, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof, in which,

Fig. 1 is a top view of a pocket knife embodying my new design;

Fig. 2 is a side view thereof; and

Fig. 3 is an end view thereof.
