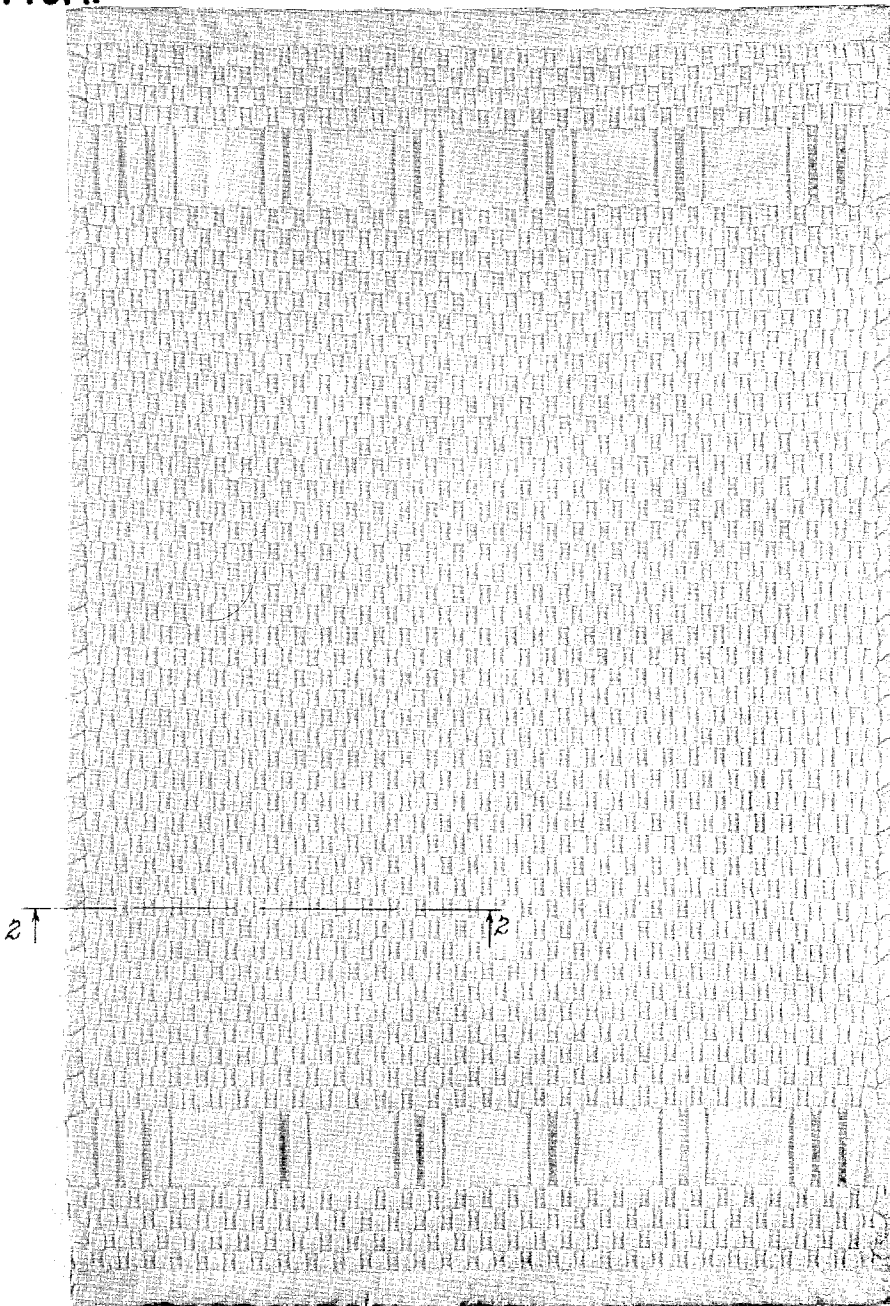

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Tillman J. Gressitt, a citizen of the United States, residing at Monkton, Maryland, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for an Embossed Plastic Table Mat, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.

Fig. 1 is a top view of an embossed plastic table mat showing my new design.

Fig. 2 is a cross-section of the embossed plastic table mat taken along the lines 2—2 of Fig. 1.
