The ornamental design for a mobile phone display screen
with animated graphical user interface, as shown and
described.

DESCRIPTION

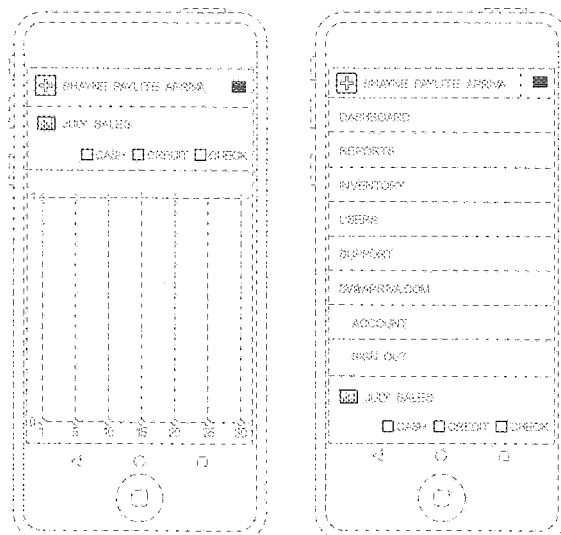
FIG. 1 is a front view of the first image in a sequence for a
mobile phone display screen with animated graphical user
interface showing our new design; and,

FIG. 2 is a front view of the second image in a sequence for
a mobile phone display screen with animated graphical user
interface showing our new design.

The outer broken lines and the broken line showing of the
lower triangle and rounded shapes illustrate a mobile phone.
The broken line at the perimeter of the figure illustrates a
display screen, and the remainder of the broken lines illus-
trate portions of the graphical user interface. None of the
broken lines form part of the claimed design.

The appearance of the transitional image sequentially tran-
sitions between the images shown in FIGS. 1 and 2. The
process or period in which one image transitions to another
image forms no part of the claimed design.

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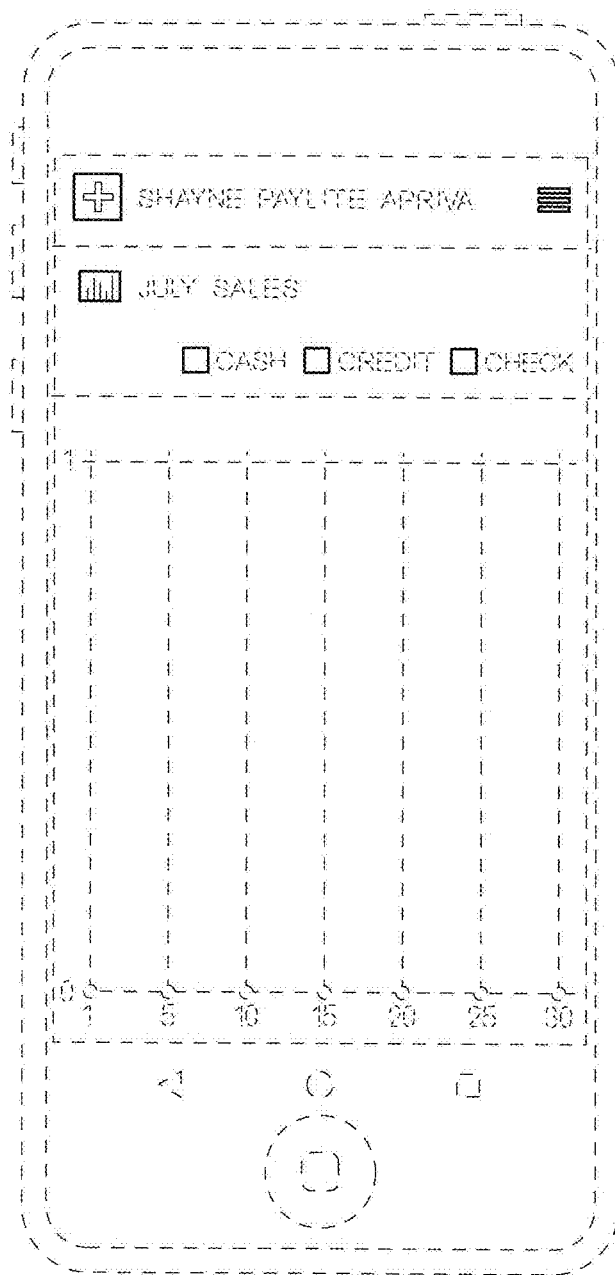
