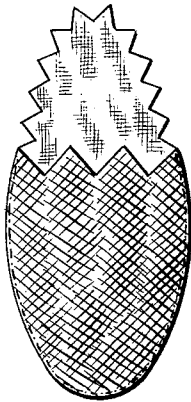

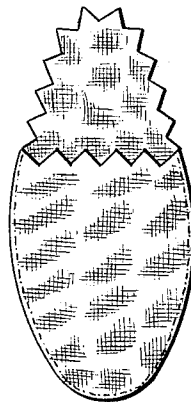

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, EDWIN G. OVER, a citizen of the United States, and a resident of Fort Worth, in the county of Tarrant and State of Texas, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Sanitary Tooth-Cleaner, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, in which—
