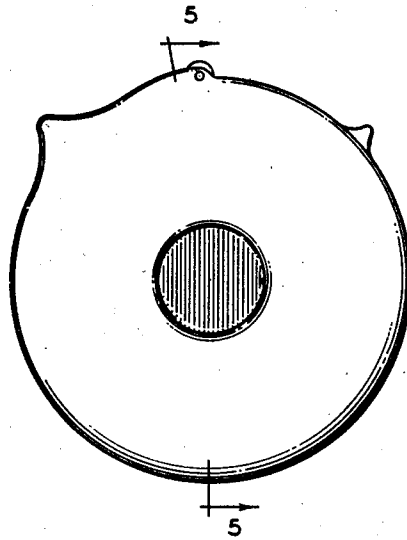

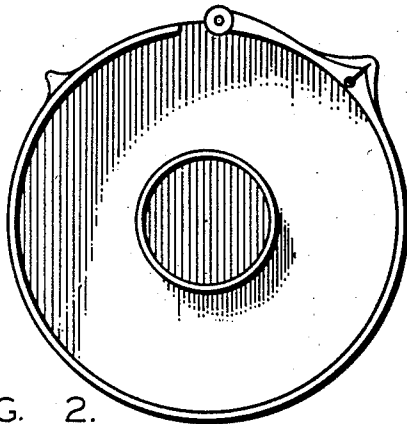

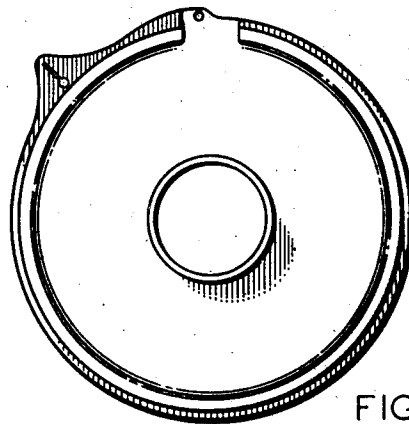

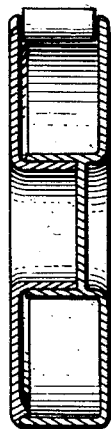

## DESIGN FOR A TAPE DISPENSER

*To all whom it may concern:*

Be it known that I, Howard L. Fischer, a citizen of the United States, residing at St. Paul, county of Ramsey, and State of Minnesota, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Tape Dispenser, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.

Fig. 1 is a side view of a tape dispenser showing my new design.

Fig. 2 is a view thereof with the cover removed.

Fig. 3 is a view of the inside of the cover.

Fig. 4 is a top edge view of the tape dispenser shown in Fig. 1.

Fig. 5 is a sectional view on line 5—5 of Fig. 1.
