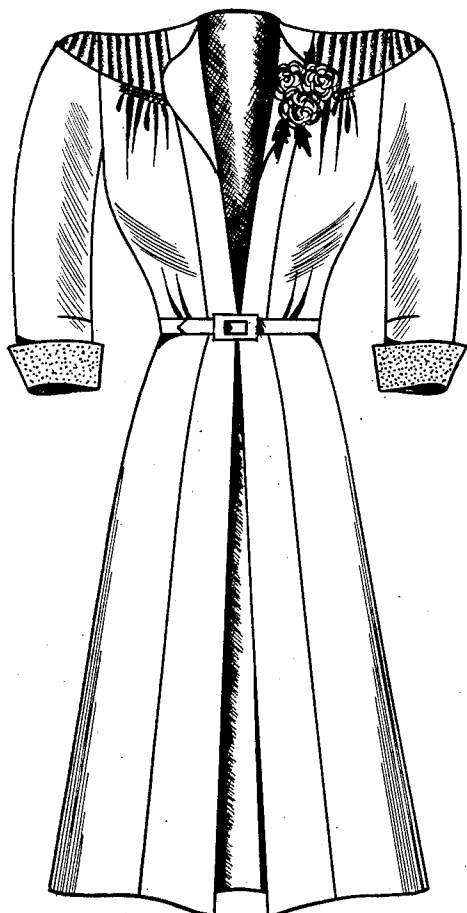

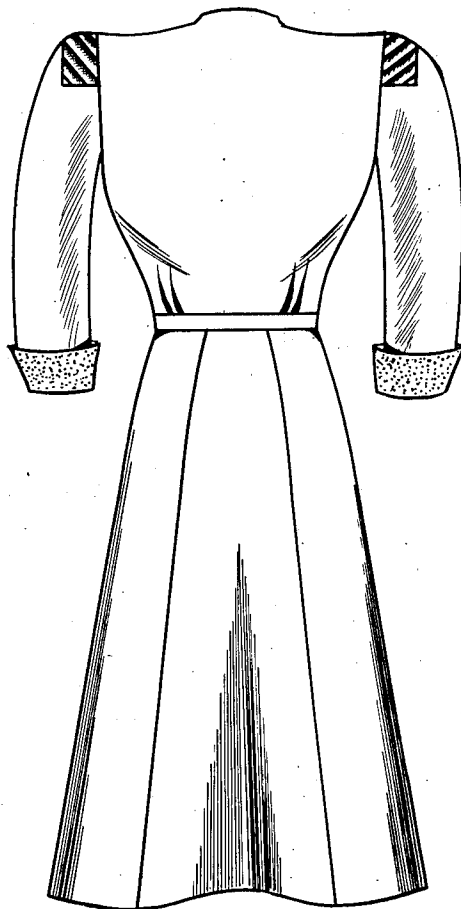

DESIGN FOR A COAT

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Blanche Price, a citizen of the United States, residing in Chicago, in the county of Cook and State of Illinois, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Coat, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.

Figure 1 is a front view of a coat, showing my new design; and

Figure 2 is a rear view of Figure 1.

Figure 3 is a fragmentary side view of the upper portion of the coat shown in Figure 1.
