

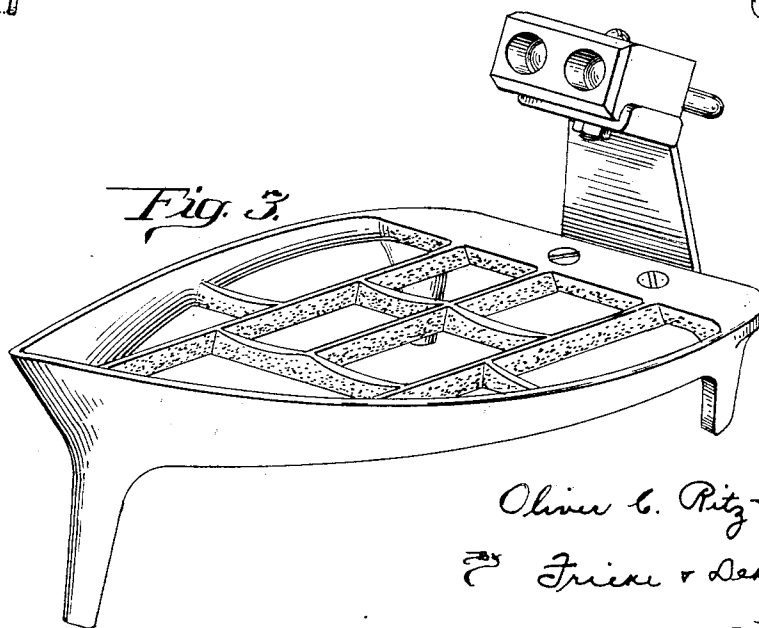
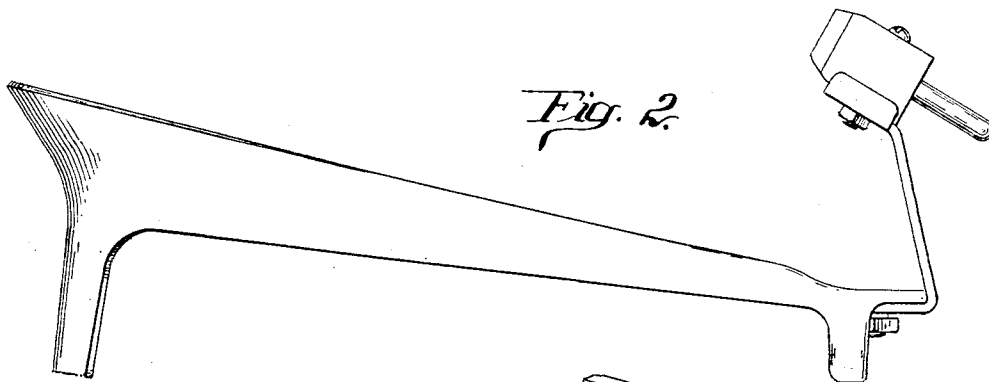
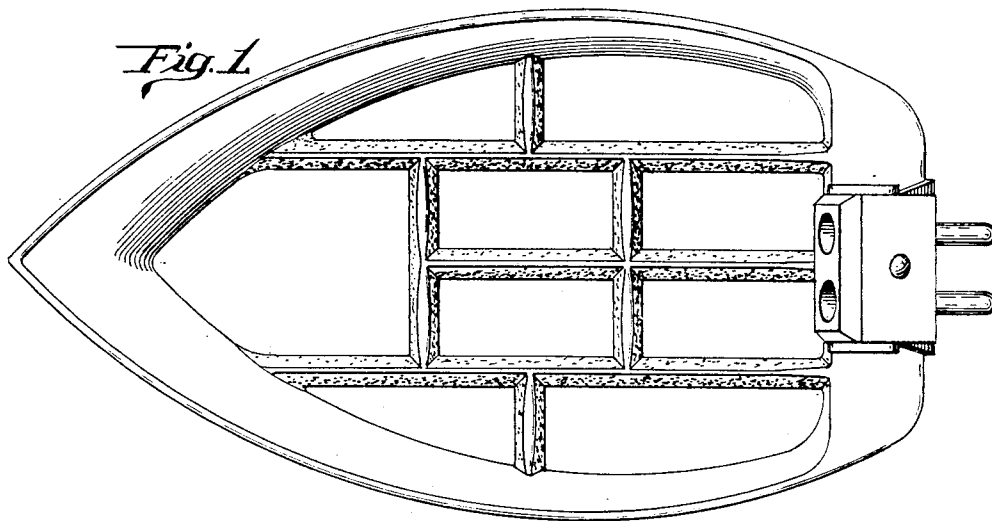

DESIGN FOR A STAND FOR AN ELECTRIC IRON

Application filed March 17, 1933. Serial No. 47,497. Term of patent 14 years.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, OLIVER C. RITZ-WOLLER, a citizen of the United States, residing at Chicago, in the county of Cook and State of Illinois, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Stand for an Electric Iron, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.

In the drawing,—

Fig. 1 is a top plan view of a stand for an electric iron embodying my new design;

Fig. 2 is a side elevational view of the stand; and

Fig. 3 is a perspective view of the stand.

I claim:—

The ornamental design for a stand for an electric iron substantially as shown.
