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11. A process according to any preceding claim, wherein a fluorescer is present
at least in step (b).
12. A process according to any preceding claim, wherein a fabric-substantive
5 polymer as a deposition aid is present during at least step (b)
13. A laundry treatment composition for fabrics which comprises:
- 10 a) a singlet-oxygen photo-bleach, to convert sebum into hydroperoxides,
and
- b) a catalyst other than the photo-bleach to decompose the
hydroperoxides formed by the reaction of the singlet-oxygen photo-
15 bleach with the sebum into odiferous species, and
- c) a fluorescer.
14. A composition according to claim 13 which further comprises a blue or
20 violet shading dye.
