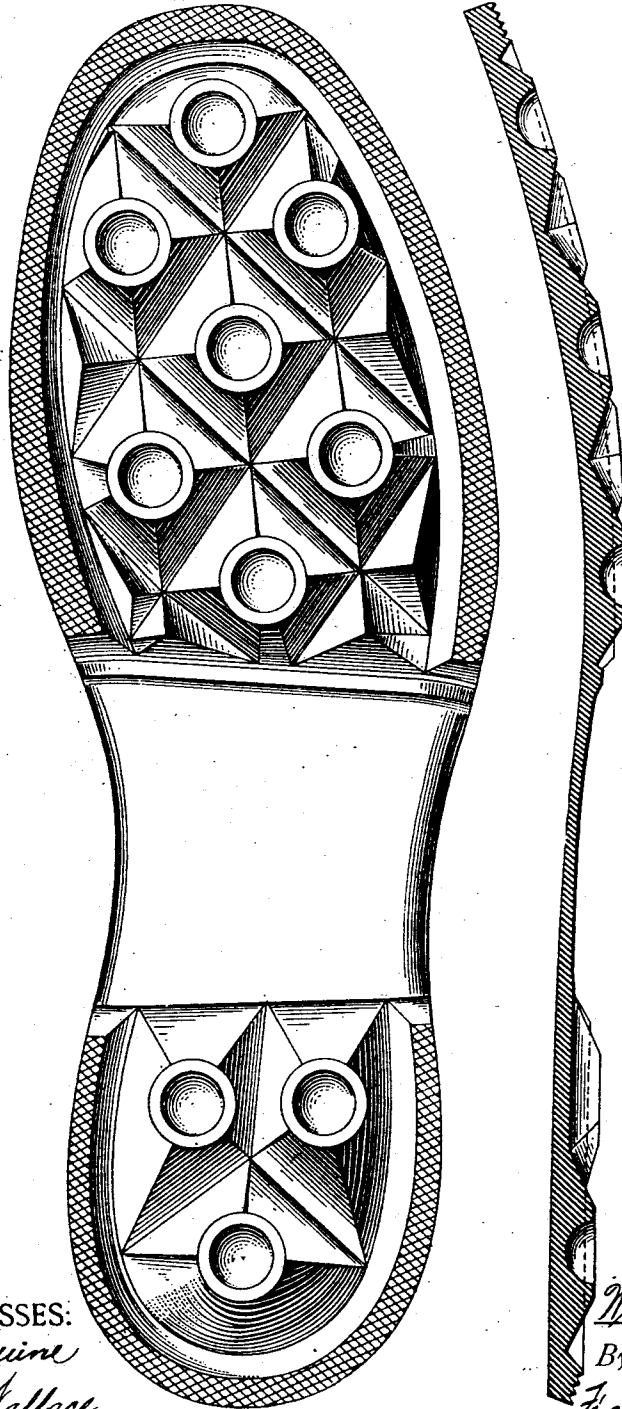

*To all whom it may concern:*

Be it known that I, WILLIAM B. HOPWOOD, a citizen of the United States, residing at Beacon Falls, in the county of New Haven and State of Connecticut, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for Soles for Footwear, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.

Figure 1 of the drawing is a face view of a sole showing my new design, and Fig. 2 is a longitudinal sectional view of the same.
