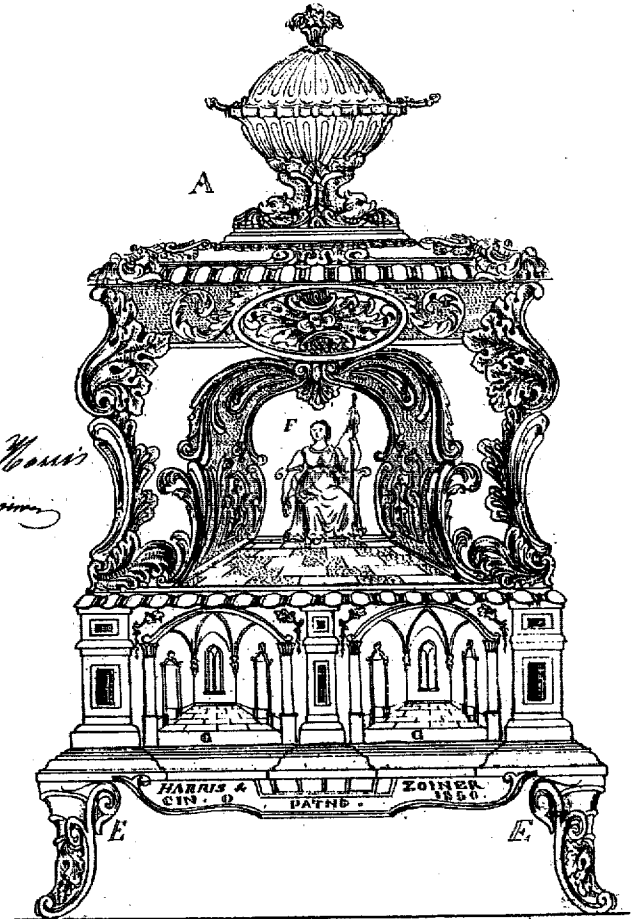
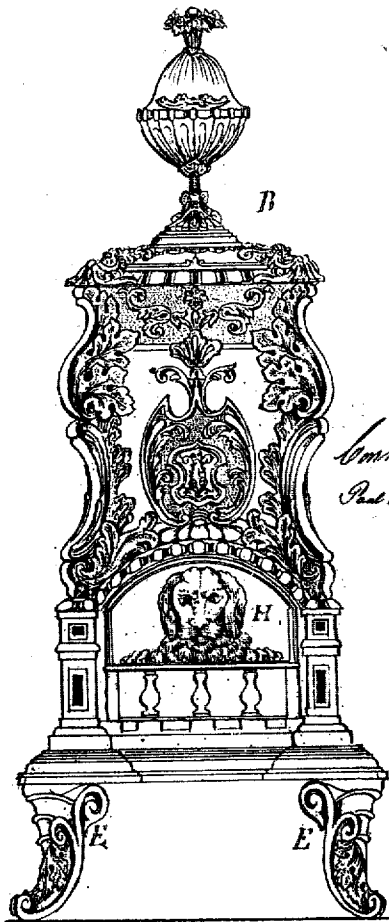
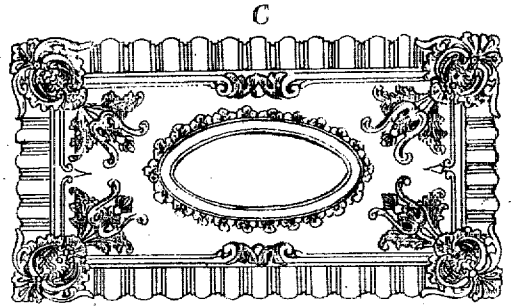
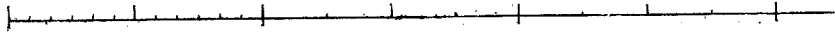

The Schedule referred to in these Setters Patent and making part of the same.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known, that we,
 Conrad Harris & Paul W. Joiner, both of Cincinnati, Hamilton County, State
 of Ohio, have invented a new ornamental Design for Coal & wood parlor stoves,
 and we do hereby declare that the following is an exact description of the same,
 to wit:

A in the annexed drawing is the surface and front
 view. B side view. C top view. D top of the urn. E side view of the foot. F
 panel in front (enclosed in the drawings with red ink) to be used in the
 Coal stove for a door. G, G, enclosed the same as F, to be used for doors on
 the Coal stove. H panel on the side (also enclosed with red ink in the draw-
 ings) to be used for a door on the wood stove.

What we claim as our invention, and desire to se-
 cure by Setters Patent, is the combination and arrangement of the above rep-
 resented scrolls, foliage, figures and mouldings, into an ornamental design
 for Coal and wood parlor stoves, to be known and called Harris &
Joiner's patent Coal & wood parlor stove.
