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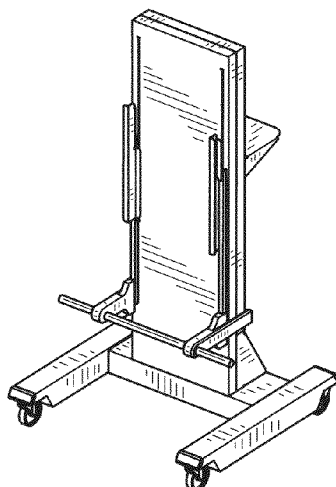
(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a TV monitor stand, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of an adjustable TV monitor stand including a platform for supporting a TV monitor;
FIG. 2 is a front view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a rear view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a top view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a bottom view thereof;
FIG. 6 is a right side view thereof;
FIG. 7 is a left side view thereof;
FIG. 8 is a perspective view of the adjustable TV monitor stand showing the stand in a highest position supporting a TV monitor; and,
FIG. 9 is a perspective view of the adjustable TV monitor stand showing the stand in a middle position supporting a TV monitor.

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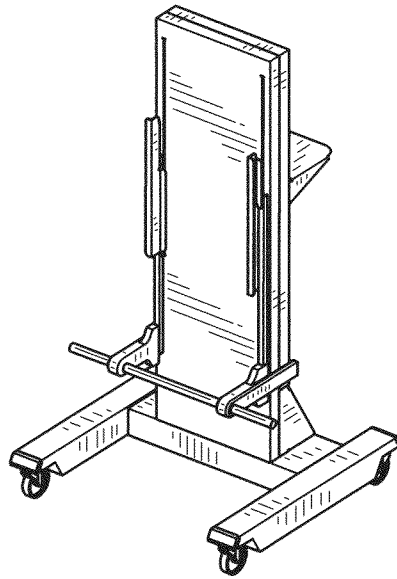

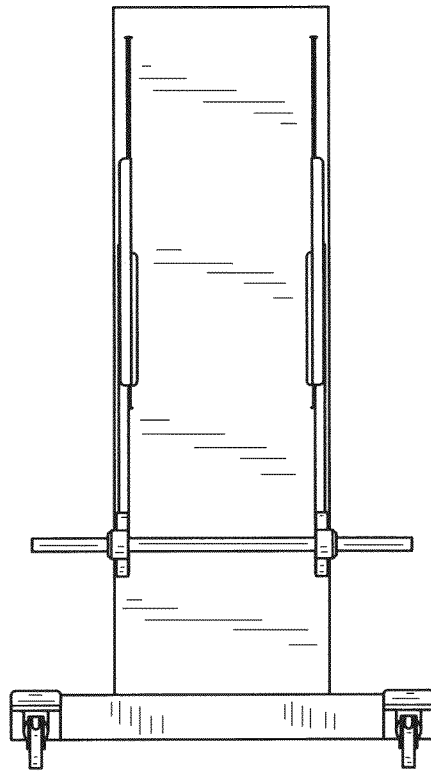

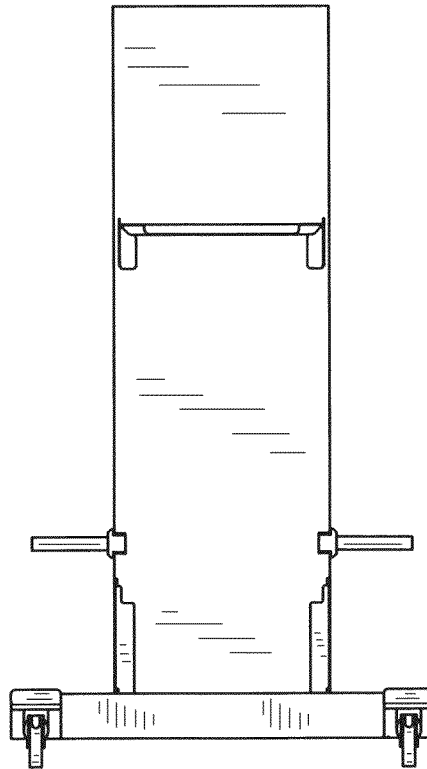

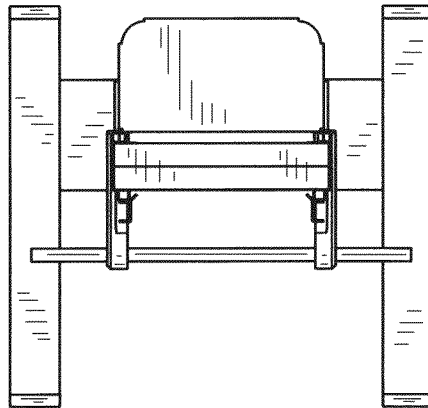

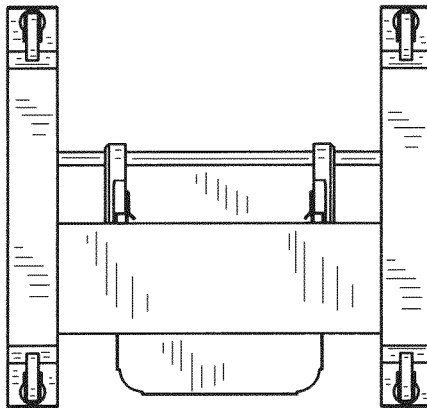

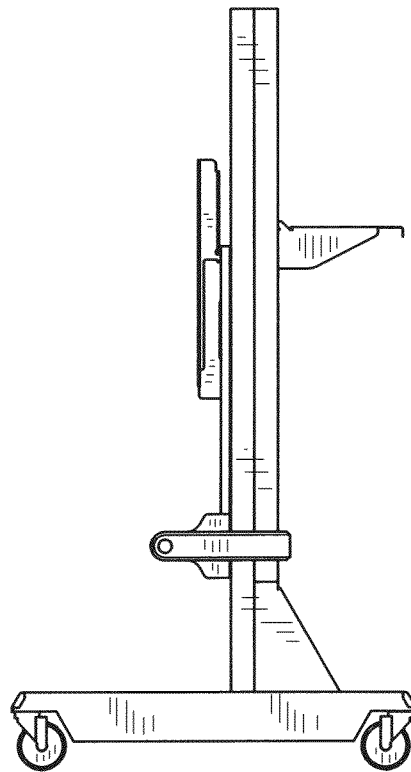

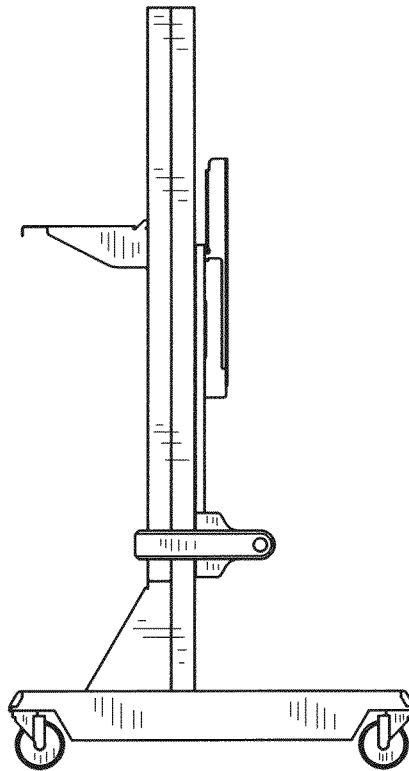

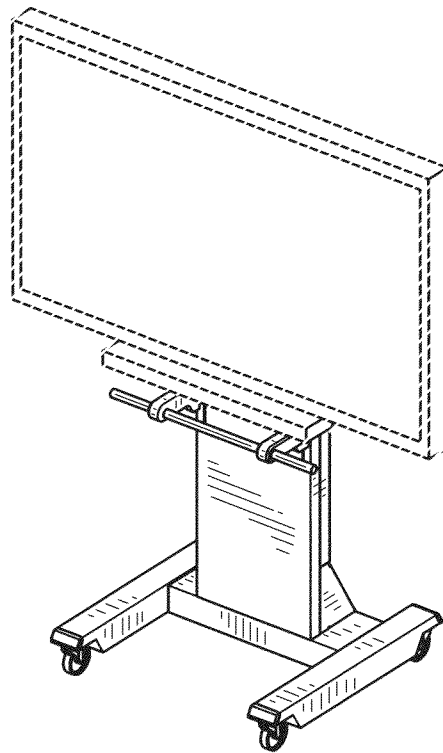

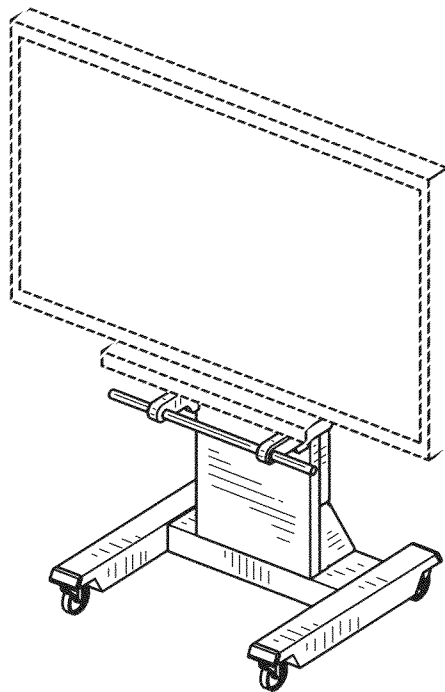
