To all whom it may concern,

Be it known that we, Conrad Harris, and Paul W. Joiner, both of Cincinnati, Hamilton County State of Ohio, have invented a new and usefull design for coal Parlor Stoves, and we do hereby declare that the following is a full and exact description of the same to wit. reference being had to the accompanying drawings, and to the letters of reference marked thereon as follows. Letter A. being a top and front view of the stove.

What we claim as our invention and desire to secure by letters patent is the ornamental design for a coal Parlor stove as herein described and represented in the annexed drawings to be known and called the Deadem.
