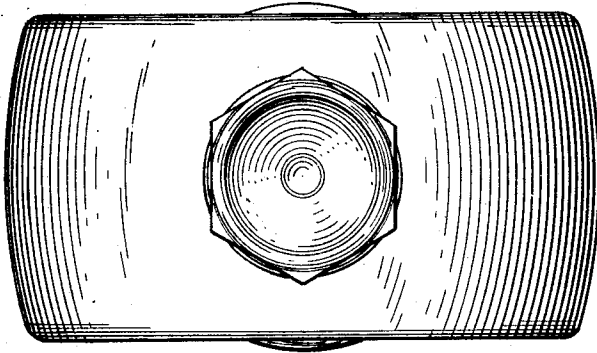

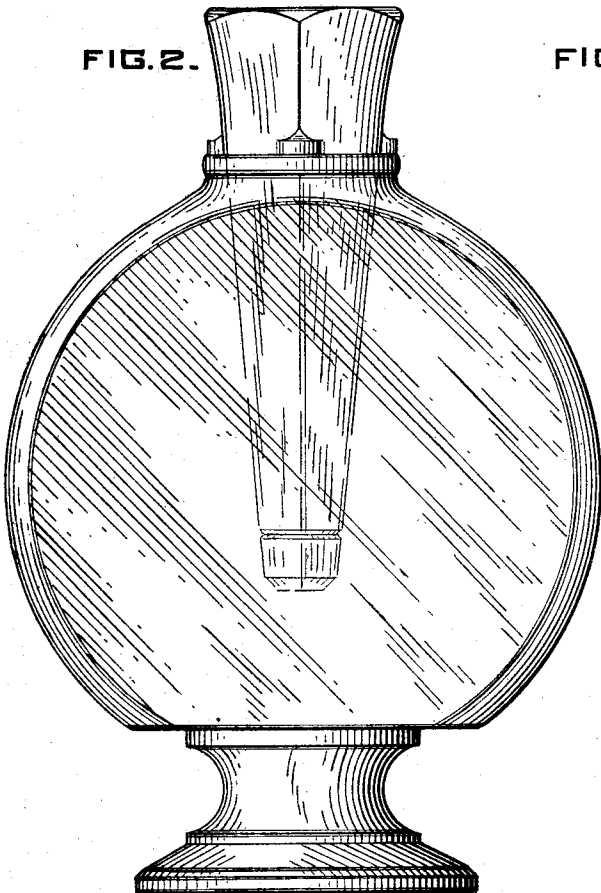
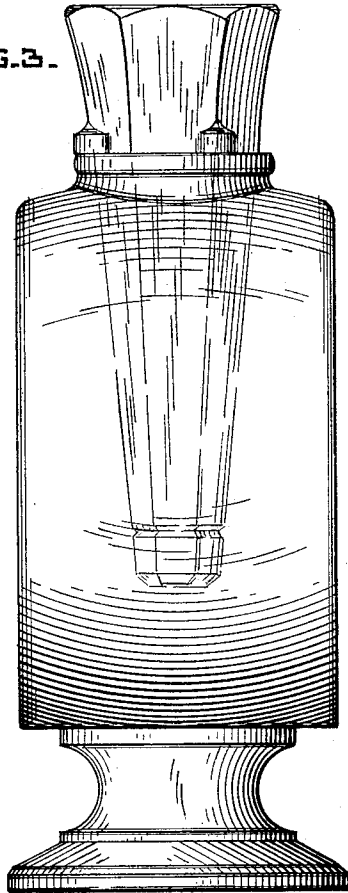

*To all whom it may concern:*

Be it known that I, GEORGE R. WEST, a citizen of the United States, residing at No. 920 Herberton street, Pittsburgh, Allegheny county, Pennsylvania, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a combined Aquarium and Vase, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part thereof.

Figure 1 is a plan view of a combined aquarium and vase, Figs. 2 and 3 are respectively side and end elevations thereof.
